Every believer's creed should be "Bible, and the Bible only"

I hold to the fundamental principle of 'the Bible, and the Bible only' as a rule of faith and conduct for every believer. Every doctrine, every principle of faith, every truth of the gospel, every standard of righteousness, is found in the Word of God. God is a God of truth. God will have a people upon the earth to maintain the Bible, and the Bible only, as the standard of all doctrines. The opinions of learned men, the deductions of science, the [church] creeds or decisions of ecclesiastical councils, as numerous and discordant as are the churches which they represent, the voice of the majority,—not one or all of these should be regarded as evidence for or against any point of religious faith. Before accepting any doctrine or precept, we should demand a plain "Thus saith the Lord" in its support. "To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them". (Isaiah 8:20) (SP)

The great apostasy that was foretold for the latter times is now here. "Now the Spirit speaks expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;" (1 Timothy 4:1). The minds of many have been so darkened and confused by worldly customs, worldly practices, and worldly influences that all power to discriminate between light and darkness, truth and error, seems destroyed. Traditions, human theology, man-made teaching, and the philosophy of so-called science have obstructed the channel of the soul. Very often, people deceived by Satan have become vain in their reasonings, and have exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and served the creature rather than the Creator. (Romans 1:25)

At the present time, so much of the experience of Israel being repeated, the teachings of philosophy, the teachings of science, the traditions of the elders and of the theological leaders, the higher criticism of the word of God, the destruction of much of the truth of the gospel, the neglect of the study of the blessed Bible. When we consider how little the Bible is studied at the present day, and how much less its grand truths are understood and practiced, we can discern that the same path in which the ancient Jews traveled is being again beaten down. The masses are depending largely upon the few church ministers and teachers to interpret the word for them, and many of these are constantly differing in opinion. Consequently spiritual death is resulting. The teachings of men in the place of the word of God are lifeless and spiritless; and with God such worship is vain.

If men would but take heed and observe what transpired as a result of the Jews instituting so many customs and false doctrines, they might be saved from falling into the same snare, as well as from the same results. God's word is true; His word is sure. What the Jews might have known they lost sight of; what the church of today may know it is not earnestly seeking for, because the teachings of the <u>law and the prophets</u> are laid aside. Then while it is called today, let the salvation of God be sought as revealed in His own word; then life, power, and blessing will come to thousands of hearts, which in turn will bless still others. The Holy Spirit, faith, conversion, salvation, sanctification, obedience, as well as all the other gifts of the Spirit, will once more be manifested with power.




☐ The Catechism of the Roman Catholic church summarizes the church's doctrinal positions and teachings.

"The most famous Roman Catholic catechism was one by Peter Canisius, a Jesuit, first published in 1555, which went through 400 editions in 150 years. One that had a large circulation and greatly influenced later works was that of Robert Bellarmine (1597). In 1992 the Vatican issued a new universal <u>Catechism of the Catholic Church</u> that summarized the church's doctrinal positions and teachings since the <u>second Vatican Council</u> (1962–65). The new catechism abandoned the question-and-answer form and used modern language in its prescriptions on faith, the sacraments, sin, and prayer."



☐ It is false doctrine to teach that the church traditions are sacred and must be accepted as equal with the holy bible.

Quote: Catechism of the catholic church

80 "Sacred Tradition and Sacred Scripture, then, are bound closely together, and communicate one with the other. For both of them, flowing out from the same divine well-spring, come together in some fashion to form one thing, and move towards the same goal." Each of them makes present and fruitful in the Church the mystery of Christ, who promised to remain with his own "always, to the close of the age". 41

82 "As a result the Church, to whom the transmission and interpretation of Revelation is entrusted, "does not derive her certainty about all revealed truths from the holy Scriptures alone. Both Scripture and Tradition must be accepted and honored with equal sentiments of devotion and reverence."⁴⁴

(Catechisms, Fundamental beliefs, church dogmas)

False Doctrine

"Creed" is a "formal and authoritative summary of fundamental points of religious belief; an authoritative statement of doctrine on points held to be vital, usually representing the views of a religious body; a confession of faith. Creeds are unchangeable and require the full acceptance of the believer.

Quote: catechism of the catholic church

196 Our presentation of the faith will follow the Apostles' Creed, which constitutes, as it were, "the oldest Roman catechism".

194 The Apostles' Creed is so called because it is rightly considered to be a faithful summary of the apostles' faith. It is the ancient baptismal symbol of the Church of Rome. Its great authority arises from this fact: it is "the Creed of the Roman Church, the See of Peter the first of the apostles, to which he brought the common faith". ¹³

13 The plan of this <u>catechism is inspired by the great tradition of catechisms</u> which build catechesis on four pillars:

979 In this battle against our inclination towards evil, who could be brave and watchful enough to escape every wound of sin? "If the Church has the power to forgive sins, then Baptism cannot be her only means of using the keys of the Kingdom of heaven received from Jesus Christ. The Church must be able to forgive all penitents their offenses, even if they should sin until the last moment of their lives." 524

982 There is no offense, however serious, that the Church cannot forgive. "There is no one, however wicked and guilty, who may not confidently hope for forgiveness, provided his repentance is honest.⁵²⁹

986 By Christ's will, the Church possesses the power to forgive the sins of the baptized and exercises it through bishops and priests normally in the sacrament of Penance.

987 "In the forgiveness of sins, both priests and sacraments are instruments which our Lord Jesus Christ, the only author and liberal giver of salvation, wills to use in order to efface our sins and give us the grace of justification" (*Roman Catechism*, I, 11, 6)

☐ It is a false doctrine introduced by the catholic church, that God is a trinity. Apostate protestant churches has adopted this doctrine to their beliefs.

Source: Catechism of the Catholic church

266 "Now this is the Catholic faith: We worship one God in the Trinity and the Trinity in unity, without either confusing the persons or dividing the substance; for the person of the Father is one, the Son's is another, the Holy Spirit's another; but the Godhead of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit is one, their glory equal, their majesty coeternal" (Athanasian Creed: DS 75; ND 16).

253 <u>The Trinity is One</u>. We do not confess three Gods, but <u>one God in three persons</u>, the "consubstantial Trinity".⁸³ The divine persons do not share the one divinity among themselves but each of them is God whole and entire: "The Father is that which the Son is, the Son that which the Father is, the Father and the Son that which the Holy Spirit is, i.e. by nature one God."⁸⁴

262 The Incarnation of God's Son reveals that God is the eternal Father and that the Son is consubstantial with the Father, which means that, in the Father and with the Father the Son is one and the same God.


God is not a trinity. The bible is categorically clear that there is only One true, personal God (the Father). The Father has a personal Son; the Lord Jesus Christ. The Holy Spirit is not a person nor a God, it is the Spirit of God and of Jesus Christ





The trinity god – 3 coequal, coeternal gods

Source: Catechism of the Catholic church

262 The Incarnation of God's Son reveals that God is the eternal Father and that the Son is consubstantial [same substance] with the Father, which means that, in the Father and with the Father the Son is one and the same God.

The doctrine of the Trinity asserts: there is one living true God: manifested in three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit;

That "the Father, the Son, and the Spirit are three divine persons who are God". And since they cannot be divided this makes one inseparable God Being.

As Roman Catholic, Graham Greene wrote,





Truth: There is only one true, personal God, The Father

There is only One personal God. He alone is the Almighty, separate and distinct from
anyone else. The Bible teaching that God is one is called monotheism and that
monotheism in its purest form does not allow for Trinity. The plain texts in the Old
Testament is strictly monotheistic. God is a single, personal, spiritual being. It is on this
basis that God gave the first commandment which prohibits multiple gods.

"Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one." (Deut 6:4)

"Father... And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent. (John 17:1, 3)

According to Jesus, "The only true God," is the Father and He did not include Himself as being part of that distinction. In other words, only true God and the one whom He has sent is clearly distinguished as two separate individuals. This is emphasized by the use of the word "and" in "the only true God AND Jesus Christ..." Moreover, knowing this "only true God" and His Son is the key to eternal life. Thus eternal life is at stake in having a correct understanding of God.

"Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and to my God, and your God. (John 20:17)

"Hear, O Israel: <u>The LORD (יְהֹוֶה Yĕhovah) our God (אֱלֹהִים 'elohiym),</u> the LORD (יְהֹוֶה <u>Yĕhovah)</u> <u>is one (אֵחָד 'echad)</u> (Deuteronomy 6:4)

"Unto thee it was shewed, that thou mightest know that the Lord he is God; THERE IS NONE ELSE beside him." (Deuteronomy 4:35)

Jesus Christ is the only begotten Son of the living God. He possess the nature of God because He is the real Son of God. Jesus Christ was affirmed as the Son of God at His birth (Luke 1:35), baptism (Luke3:22), transfiguration (Luke 9:35) by John the Baptist (John 1:34), His disciples (Matt 14:33; 16:16), by demons (Mark 5:7), at His trial (Luke 22:70), at the cross (Mark 15:39), and at His resurrection (Romans 1:4).

Truth: Who or what is the Holy Spirit?

(Is the holy Spirit truly God?)

PART 1

The identity of the Holy Spirit. Who or what is the Holy Spirit?

It is believed by many that the Holy Spirit is a separate, distinct, personal being like
God the Father and His Son. The reason being, that the Scriptures refer to the Holy
Spirit as "He" and is said to be displaying all the attributes of a "person" and is
seemingly doing things that a real person would do. And with that understanding,
most view the "Spirit of God" which "moved upon the face of the waters" recorded
for us in creation account, to be a separate, formless individual God Being. But let's
consider for a moment how the Bible actually defines what the "spirit" is.

☐ If you look up the Hebrew word, "spirit" in the Strong's Concordance, he/it is described as the wind, breath, mind, spirit (Strong's H7307 Ruwach)

The holy Spirit is the spirit of Jesus Christ

"The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God." (Romans 8:16)

"For a know that this shall turn to my salvation through your prayer, and the supply of <u>the</u> Spirit of Jesus Christ", (Philippians 1:19)

Jesus: "And when he had said this, he breathed on them, and saith unto them, Receive ye the Holy Ghost:" (John 20:21-22)

"For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God" (Romans 8:14)

"For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death". Romans 8:2

"the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered." (Romans 8:26)

"And I will put my Spirit in you and move you to follow my decrees and be careful to keep my laws". (Ezekiel 36:27)

<u>The Spirit of the Lord will rest on Him</u>, The spirit of wisdom and understanding, The spirit of counsel and strength, The spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord. (Isaiah 11:2)

PART 2

"Spirit" is the breath of God, His spoken word and the creative, life-giving power

And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the **breath of** (H5397 něshamah); and man became a living soul.

"By the word of the LORD were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth (H7307 ruwach)." (Psalms 33:6)

"For he spake, and it was done, he commanded, and it stood fast." (Psalms 33:9)

Compare this with

"He divideth the sea with His power, and by His understanding He smiteth through the proud. **By His spirit** (Strong's H7307 ruwach) **He hath garnished the heavens**; His hand hath formed the crooked serpent." (Job 26:12-13)

"The spirit (ruwach) of God hath made me, and the breath (H5397 něshamah) of the Almighty hath given me life." (Job 33:4)

"Thou sendest forth thy spirit (ruwach), they are created: and thou renewest the face of the earth. (Psalm 104:30)

We are told here that it was by the "breath of his mouth" that the heavens were made and yet the Scripture synonymously describe the Spirit of God doing the same. Please note that the "breath of his mouth" mentioned in Psalms 33:6 is the very same word translated as the "spirit" in Genesis 1:2, Job 33:4 and Psalm 104:30.

☐ Holy Spirit-the omnipresence of God; it is His own Spirit

"The Lord looketh from heaven; he beholdeth all the sons of men. 14 From the place of his habitation he looketh upon all the inhabitants of the earth." (Psalm 33:13-14)

"Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me." (Psalms 51:11)

"Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence? 8 If I ascend up into heaven, thou art there: if I make my bed in hell, behold, thou art there. 9 If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea; 10 Even there shall thy hand lead me, and thy right hand shall hold me." (Psalms 139: 7-10)

"Am I a God at hand, saith the Lord, and not a God afar off? Can any hide himself in secret places that I shall not see him? saith the Lord. Do not I fill heaven and earth? saith the Lord?" (Jeremiah 23:23, 24)

☐ Spirit is the mind of God

"And immediately when Jesus perceived in his **spirit** [Strongs G4151: pneuma] that they so reasoned within themselves, he said unto them, Why reason ye these things in your hearts?" **(Mark 2:8)** Jesus perceived [Strong's G1921: epiginwskw – epiginosko "to know, that is to understand"] in His Spirit. The Spirit of Jesus is where He knew and understood things. The Spirit of Jesus is the mind of Jesus. "And **the Spirit** [ruwach H7307] of the LORD fell upon me, and said unto me, Speak; Thus saith the LORD; Thus have ye said, O house of Israel: for I know the things that come into **your mind** [ruwach H7307], every one of them." **(Ezekiel 11:5)**

In this passage, the Hebrew word, ruwach was translated as "spirit" in one place, and "mind" in another. Clearly you can see that the spirit of an individual is the mind or thinking of that individual. Spirit of God is the very mind of God. (See Gen 41:8, Psalm 77:3, Daniel 2:1-3; 7:15, John11:33, John 13:21, Isaiah 40:13, Romans 11:34)

False: That Jesus was not the Messiah

(Jews and Islam reject Jesus was not the Messiah)

False Doctrine

☐ Jewish people and Judaism reject JESUS was not the Messiah.

"Jesus is rejected in <u>Judaism</u> as a failed <u>Jewish messiah</u> <u>claimant</u> and a <u>false prophet</u> by most Jewish denominations. Judaism also considers the worship of any person a form of <u>idolatry</u>, and rejects the claim that Jesus was divine".

"Judaism affirms that Jesus did not fulfill the <u>messianic</u> <u>prophecies</u> by ushering in an era of universal peace (Isaiah 2:4), building the Third Temple (Ezekiel 37:26–28), and gathering all Jews back to the Land of Israel (Isaiah 43:5–6)". https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Rejection of Jesus

"Judaism, which includes Orthodox Judaism, Haredi Judaism, Hasidic Judaism, Reform Judaism, Conservative Judaism, Reconstructionist Judaism, Karaite Judaism, and Samaritan Judaism, entirely rejects the idea of Jesus being a God,..., or a mediator to God who has a special relationship with Him that somehow makes Jesus "divine". Moreover, it is Avodah Zarah ("foreign worship", which means idolatry) to regard or worship a human being as God" (source: Wikipedia)

Jesus is truly divine. "Christ, the Word, the only begotten of God, was one with the eternal Father—<u>one in nature</u>, <u>in character</u>, <u>in purpose</u>—the only being that could enter into all the counsels and purposes of God."

"¹ God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, ² has in these last days spoken to us by *His* Son, whom <u>He has appointed heir of all things</u>, through whom also He made the worlds; ³ who <u>being the brightness of *His* glory and the express image of His person," (Hebrews 1: 1-3)</u>

False: Denial of the Divinity of Jesus

(Islam and Quran deny Jesus physically died on the cross)

☐ The Quran rejects the <u>Christian view</u> of <u>the divinity of Jesus</u> as <u>God incarnate</u>, or the literal Son of God.



"The Quran rejects the <u>Christian view</u> of <u>the divinity of Jesus</u> as <u>God incarnate</u>, or the literal <u>Son of God</u>. It denies Jesus as a deity in several verses, and also mentions that Jesus did not claim to be divine. Muslims believe that Jesus' original message was <u>altered</u> (taḥrīf), after him being raised alive. The monotheism (tawḥīd) of Jesus is emphasized in the Quran. Like all <u>prophets in Islam</u>, Jesus is also called a <u>Muslim</u>, as he preached that his followers should adopt the '<u>straight path</u>' (Ṣirāṭ al-Mustaqīm). Jesus is attributed with a vast number of miracles in Islamic tradition.



"In <u>Islamic eschatology</u>, Jesus will return in the <u>Second Coming</u> with Imam <u>Mahdi</u> to kill the <u>Al-Masih ad-Dajjal</u> ('The False Messiah'), after which with the ancient tribes <u>Gog and Magog</u> would disperse. After these creatures would miraculously perish, Imam Mahdi and Jesus would rule the entire world, establish peace and justice, and die after a reign of 40 years. Some Muslims believe that he would then be buried alongside Muhammad at the fourth reserved tomb of the <u>Green Dome in Medina</u>."

<u>An-Nisa</u>'s verse 157 is the primary verse of the Quran to refer to the event of Jesus' crucifixion. It says that Jesus was not killed and neither crucified, but "it was made to appear to them":

An-Nisa's verse 157

"That they said (in boast), "We killed Christ, Jesus the son of Mary, the Messenger of The God'; but they killed him not, nor crucified him, but so it was made to appear to them, and those who differ therein are full of doubts, with no (certain) knowledge, but only conjecture to follow, for of a surety they killed him not."

"Most Islamic traditions categorically deny that Jesus physically died on the cross or otherwise. According to the Quran, he was not <u>crucified</u>, but was rather saved by God. (Although the earliest Islamic traditions and exegesis quote somewhat conflicting reports regarding a death and its length, Muslims believe that Jesus did not die on the cross, but believe that he was saved by being <u>raised alive to heaven</u>)".

"The <u>Son of man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men</u>, and be <u>crucified</u>, and <u>the third day</u> <u>rise again"</u>. (Luke 24:7)

"For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that <u>Christ died for our sins</u> <u>according to the scripture</u>; and that <u>he was buried</u>, and that he <u>rose again the third day</u>". (1 Cor 15:3-4)

False: Jesus is not the only saviour of man

(Islam and Judaism denies Jesus has power to forgive sins)

False Doctrine





"Islam rejects the idea that Jesus death had any significance whatsoever. On the contrary, they do not believe that it was Jesus who died upon the cross! Salvation, in Islam, is based upon the deeds of a person". The Quran says,

"They whose balances shall be heavy shall be blest. But they whose balances shall be light, they shall lose their soul, abiding in hell forever (Surah 23:102-104).

There is no offer of forgiveness based upon repentance. The Quran says elsewhere,

"Surely Allah does not forgive that anything should be associated with Him, and forgives what is besides that to whomsoever He pleases; and whoever associates anything with Allah, he devises indeed a great sin (Surah 4:48).

- ⁹ I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture. (John 10:9)

False: That Jesus is not a High Priest in heaven

(and that there is no heavenly sanctuary)

False Doctrine

☐ There are many Christians who do not believe in the existence of a heavenly sanctuary. They do not know what work JESUS is doing today in heaven. This is dangerous heresy because they are deceived to believe that their sins will be forgiven, not now, but the day Christ will come a second time, or when they are dead.

Jesus is a high priest ministering in the heavenly sanctuary today.

There is a sanctuary in heaven, the true tabernacle which the Lord set up and not man. In it Christ ministers on our behalf, making available to believers the benefits of His atoning sacrifice he offered once for all on the cross. At His ascension, He was inaugurated as our great High Priest and began His intercessory ministry, which was typified by the work of the high priest in the holy place of the earthly sanctuary.

"Now of the things which we have spoken this is the sum: We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens; A minister of the sanctuary, and of the true tabernacle, which the Lord pitched, and not man." (Heb 8:1-2)

"For he hath looked down from the height of <u>his sanctuary; from heaven</u> did the LORD behold the earth;" (Psa 102:19)

"But the LORD is in his holy temple: let all the earth keep silence before him." (Hab 2:20)

"But Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this building;" (Heb 9:11) "For Christ has entered, not into holy places made with hands, which are copies of true things, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God on our behalf" (Hebrews 9:24, ESV).

False: Baptism by sprinkling (or pouring water on the head)

False Doctrine

It is false doctrine to baptize by sprinkling or pouring water on the head. Others dip people three times; once for each person of the false trinity god.

Source: Catechism of the Catholic church

1278 The essential rite of Baptism consists in immersing the candidate in water or pouring water on his head, while pronouncing the invocation of the Most Holy Trinity: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

1284 In case of necessity, any person can baptize provided that he have the intention of doing that which the Church does and provided that he pours water on the candidate's head while saying: "I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

- The description of baptisms in the New Testament show that people <u>went down into</u> the water (full immersion) rather than pouring on forehead or sprinkling.
 - ¹⁶ And Jesus, when he was baptized, <u>went up straightway out of the water</u>: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him. (Matthew 3:16)
 - ²³ And John also was baptizing in Aenon near to Salim, because <u>there was much water</u> there: and they came, and were baptized. (John 3:23)
 - ³⁸ And he commanded the chariot to stand still: and they went down both into the water, both Philip and the eunuch; and he baptized him. ³⁹ And when they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing.

(Acts 8: 38-39)

¹²when you were <u>buried with him</u> in baptism, you were also <u>raised with</u> him through faith in the power of God, who raised him from the dead. (Colossians 2:12)



False: Infants baptism

('Infant Baptism is an ancient tradition of the Church')

☐ The practice of infant Baptism is an "immemorial tradition of the catholic Church".

The Baptism of infants

1250 Born with a fallen human nature and tainted by original sin, children also have need of the new birth in Baptism to be freed from the power of darkness and brought into the realm of the freedom of the children of God, to which all men are called. The sheer gratuitousness of the grace of salvation is particularly manifest in infant Baptism. The Church and the parents would deny a child the priceless grace of becoming a child of God were they not to confer Baptism shortly after birth. The confer Baptism shortly after birth.

1252 The practice of infant Baptism is an immemorial tradition of the Church. There is explicit testimony to this practice from the second century on, and it is quite possible that, from the beginning of the apostolic preaching, when whole "households" received baptism, infants may also have been baptized.⁵³

1282 Since the earliest times, Baptism has been administered to children.

- "<u>Believe</u> and <u>Repent</u> and be <u>baptized</u>" ...'for the remission of sins'. "By the law is the knowledge of sin" (Romans 3:20). The question is, if infants were to be baptized, they <u>Must</u> know the law first to know their sins, then believe, then repent, then be baptized. Do children have a clear understanding of all this?
- □ "Repentance and believe (faith) are required as a condition of receiving baptism
- ³⁸ Then Peter said unto them, <u>Repent</u>, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. (Acts 2:38)
- ¹² But when they <u>believed</u> Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women. (Acts 8:12)
- ⁴Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of <u>repentance</u>, saying unto the people, that they should <u>believe</u> on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus. (Acts 19:4)
- ¹⁶ He that <u>believeth</u> and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. (Mark 16:16)

False: The human soul is immortal

(that soul lives on separately after the physical body dies)

False Doctrine

Most religions believe the soul lives on separately after the physical body dies. Most professing Christians call this the immortal soul.

Source: Catechism of the Catholic church

366 The Church teaches that every spiritual soul is created immediately by God - it is not "produced" by the parents - <u>and also that it is immortal</u>: it <u>does not perish when it separates from the body at dea</u>th, and <u>it will be reunited with the body at the final Resurrection.²³⁵</u>

382 "Man, though made of body and soul, is a unity" (*GS* 14 § 1). The doctrine of the faith affirms that the spiritual and <u>immortal soul</u> is created immediately by God.

1703 Endowed with "a spiritual <u>and immortal" soul,</u> the human person is "the only creature on earth that God has willed for its own sake." From his conception, he is destined for eternal beatitude.

All human souls are mortal. The souls die/perish when a person's body dies. GOD the Father, and his Son JESUS CHRIST are the only ones who are immortal.

Beyond all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: "The soul that sin, it shall die," (Ezekiel 18:20)

And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in Hell. (Matthew 10:28)

■ Only God and Jesus Christ have Immortality

¹⁵ Which in his times he shall shew, who is the blessed and only <u>Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords</u>; ¹⁶ Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom be honour and power everlasting. Amen. (1 Timothy 6: 15-16)

¹⁰ But is now made manifest by the appearing of our <u>Saviour Jesus Christ</u>, who hath abolished death, and <u>hath brought life and immortality</u> to light through the gospel: (2 Timothy 1:10)

False: People are conscious in death

[souls of dead people have full consciousness in death]

False Doctrine

It is a false doctrine to believe that people can communicate with the dead. And people can pray for the dead or the dead can pray for the living.

958 <u>Communion with the dead</u>. "<u>In full consciousness</u> of this communion of the whole Mystical Body of Jesus Christ, the Church in its pilgrim members, from the very earliest days of the Christian religion, has honored with great respect the memory of the dead; and 'because it is a holy and a wholesome thought to <u>pray for the dead that they may be loosed from their sins</u>' she offers her suffrages for them." <u>Our prayer for them is capable not only of helping them, but also of making their intercession for us effective</u>.



"The dead know nothing" (Ecclesiastes 9:5-6)

☐ God says: The dead know nothing, they have no knowledge or wisdom in the grave.

"Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with your might; for there is no work or device or knowledge or wisdom in the grave where you are going". (Ecclesiastes 9:10)

"For the living know that they will die; But the dead know nothing, And they have no more reward, For the memory of them is forgotten. 6 Also their love, their hatred, and their envy have now perished; Nevermore will they have a share In anything done under the sun". (Ecclesiastes 9:5-6)

"As the cloud disappears and vanishes away, So he who goes down to the grave does not come up. 10 He shall never return to his house, Nor shall his place know him anymore". (Job 7:9-10)

"For in death there is no remembrance of You; (Psalm 6:5)

False: A person receives the eternal reward at the very moment of his death

(with righteous going directly to heaven and sinners to hell)

False Doctrine

☐ It is a false doctrine to believe the righteous goes direct to heaven and the sinners goes to hell or to purgatory upon death.

1022 Each man receives his eternal retribution in his immortal soul at the very moment of his death, in a particular judgment that refers his life to Christ: either entrance into the blessedness of heaven-through a purification⁵⁹⁴ or immediately,⁵⁹⁵ -- or immediate and everlasting damnation.⁵⁹⁶

1021 Death puts an end to human life as the time open to either accepting or rejecting the divine grace manifested in Christ.⁵⁹² The New Testament speaks of judgment primarily in its aspect of the final encounter with Christ in his second coming, but also repeatedly affirms that each will be rewarded immediately after death in accordance with his works and faith.

1035 ... Immediately after death the souls of those who die in a state of mortal sin descend into hell, where they suffer the punishments of hell, "eternal fire."

When will the righteous receive their eternal rewards?

God plainly state that only at the last day, - the day Christ will come a second time, shall the righteous receive their eternal reward and be taken to the heavenly city. The sinners will receive their rewards 1,000 year later.

"Men and brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the <u>patriarch David</u>, that he is both dead and <u>buried</u>, and his sepulcher is with us unto this day." "<u>For David is not ascended into the heavens</u>." (Acts 2:29, 34)

¹⁴ And you will be blessed, because they cannot repay you; for <u>you shall be repaid at the resurrection of the just.</u>" (Luke 14:14)

"I have hope in God, which they themselves also accept, that there will be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and the unjust" (Acts 24:15)

"having a hope in God, which these men cherish themselves, that there shall certainly be a resurrection of both the righteous and the wicked." (Acts 24:15)

⁷I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith:

⁸ Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing. (2 Timothy 4:7-8)

False: believe in purgatory

(A place where imperfect people go after death to be purified before being taken to the joy of heaven)

False Doctrine

What is purgatory? "A state of final purification after death and before entrance into heaven for those who died in God's friendship, but were only imperfectly purified; a final cleansing of human imperfections before one is able to enter the joy of heaven". (Catechism of the catholic church, 1031; see also CCC, 1472)

III. THE FINAL PURIFICATION, OR PURGATORY

1030 All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven.

1031 The Church gives the name *Purgatory* to this final purification of the elect, which is entirely different from the punishment of the damned. The Church formulated her doctrine of faith on Purgatory especially at the Councils of Florence and Trent. The tradition of the Church, by reference to certain texts of Scripture, speaks of a cleansing fire: 607

ALL GO TO THE GRAVE, RIGHTEOUS and SINNERS ALIKE, to await resurrection and reward. The Bible clearly teaches that the dead do not go immediately to Heaven. They are represented as sleeping in the graves until the resurrection.

"Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of His saints, to execute judgment upon all." (Jude 1:14-15)

"Just as people are destined to die once, and after that to face judgment" (Hebrews 9:27)

"28 Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, 29 And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation. (John 5:28-29)

³¹ Because <u>he hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world</u> in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath raised him from the dead. (Acts 17:31)

False: Prayers for the dead

(claim people can pray for the dead or dead can pray for the living)

False Doctrine


☐ Catholics prays for the dead including prayers to the dead Virgin Mary and saints.

1032 This teaching is also based on the practice of prayer for the dead, already mentioned in Sacred Scripture: "Therefore [Judas Maccabeus] made atonement for the dead, that they might be delivered from their sin." 609

1055 By virtue of the "communion of saints," the Church commends the dead to God's mercy and offers her prayers, especially the holy sacrifice of the Eucharist, on their behalf.

1414 As sacrifice, the Eucharist is also offered <u>in reparation</u> <u>for the sins of the living and the dead</u> and to obtain spiritual or temporal benefits from God.

False: Modern spiritualism

(False claim the dead loved ones speak to the living)

False Doctrine

"Spiritualism, in religion, a movement based on the belief that departed souls can interact with the living. Spiritualists sought to make contact with the dead, usually through the assistance of a medium, a person believed to have the ability to contact spirits directly. Some mediums worked while in a trancelike state, and some claimed to be the catalyst for various paranormal physical phenomena (including the materializing or moving of objects) through which the spirits announced their presence. A core belief of spiritualism is that individuals survive the deaths of their bodies by ascending into a spirit existence."

Hell is eternal

1035 The teaching of the Church affirms the existence of hell and its eternity. Immediately after death the souls of those who die in a state of mortal sin descend into hell, where they suffer the punishments of hell, "eternal fire." The chief punishment of hell is eternal separation from God, in whom alone man can possess the life and happiness for which he was created and for which he longs.

1051 Every man receives his eternal recompense in his immortal soul from the moment of his death in a particular judgment by Christ, the judge of the living and the dead.

The truth about Hell is only attained when everything written about the topic is resolved into perfect harmony. The Bible indicates that God has three purposes for Hell. In a nutshell, the first purpose is **justice**, the second purpose is to **execute** the wicked, and the third purpose is to **purify the** Earth.



The fact that the hell fire is "not quenched" means it keeps burning until nothing put in it finally remains

2. The Bible declares that God is love. (1 John 4:16) Love is the perfect balance of mercy and justice. This means that God loves mercy, as well as justice. (Ps 89:14; Mat 23:23) The Bible states that God's eyes constantly sweep over the Earth. (1 Chron 16:9; Ps 139:8) God sees every act of kindness done in secret and He rewards accordingly. (Mat 6:4-6) God also sees every act of violence, watches every theft, observes every adultery, and hears every lie. (2 Chron 16:9; Ps 139:8) The reason that God's omniscient oversight is important in this study on Hell is **restitution**. Contrary to what many people think, God requires that every sin be made right before He will forgive us of that sin.* (Ex 21; Mat 5:23,24, 1 John 1:9) For example, God will not forgive a thief until the thief has provided restitution to his victim! God will not forgive our sins unless we truly repent, and the evidence of true repentance is restitution. (Mat 5:23,24).

Why will God resurrects the wicked dead at the end of the 1,000 years? He resurrects the wicked to extract the restitution they refused to pay. After justice has been served, they will be executed. **Eternal death** means there will be no resurrection from this death. Justice is the first purpose for the fires of Hell. Remember, the second purpose is to execute the wicked and the final purpose is to purify of Earth.

The fires of Hell will extract restitution and will not burn out until justice has been served and restitution has been "paid in full." (Mark 9:43) The fires of Hell will not burn eternally. After the wicked people's torture is over, the wicked will perish. "Surely the day is coming; it will burn like a furnace. All the arrogant and every evildoer will be stubble, and that day that is coming will set them on fire, says the Lord Almighty. Not a root or a branch will be left to them. . . Then you will trample down the wicked; they will be ashes under the soles of your feet on the day when I do these things, says the Lord Almighty." (Malachi 4:1,2).

God has promised that at the end of the world, every wrong will be atoned for and He will even resurrect dead people to achieve justice. (Heb 10:30, 31; Mat 25:46). Since the fires of Hell will also extract restitution from the devil and his angels, The devil will burn the longest, everyone in Hell will eventually die and when the wicked no longer exist, Jesus will create a new Heaven and a new Earth. John wrote, "Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea." (Revelation 21:1).

If hell was eternal: then A person cannot writhe in Hell throughout eternity without first receiving eternal life. In other words, a wicked person has to receive eternal life so that he can be tortured for eternity. The Bible teaches the wicked will not receive eternal life. In fact, the Bible teaches that the wicked will perish cease to exist. (See John 3:16 above.)

- 3. **Two Resurrections:** Let us assume for a moment that a wicked person does go to Hell at the time of death. Then, try to explain why the wicked are then resurrected at the end of the 1,000 years? What is the point of resurrecting Cain (the first murderer) if he has been burning in Hell for the past 6,000 years? Even more, what would be the point of resurrecting Abel if he has been sitting at Jesus' side for the past 6,000 years?
- The doctrine of two resurrections is in direct conflict with the doctrine of an eternally burning hell. The Bible teaches the first resurrection occurs at the Second Coming for the righteous dead (1 Thessalonians 4:15-18, Rev 20:6) and the second resurrection occurs at the end of the 1,000 years. (Rev 20:5) The second resurrection is for the wicked of all ages.

- 4. Immediate Judgment at Death: The Bible states that everyone will stand before "the Judgment Bar of Christ." (2 Cor 5:10) If a person goes to Heaven or Hell at the time of death, this presumes that "the Judgment Bar of Christ" has been in session ever since Abel was killed. The problem is that "the Judgment Bar of Christ" has a beginning point in time and an ending point in time. The apocalyptic books of Daniel and Revelation tell us the Judgment Bar of Christ began in 1844 and closes during the Great Tribulation, at the end of the 1,260 days allotted to the Two Witnesses, just before the seventh trump. No one can be judged by Christ until His Judgment Bar is "set up." So, Bible prophecy indicates that immediate judgment at death is not possible.
- 5. First Heaven and Earth Passed Away: The Bible teaches that God will create a New Heaven and New Earth after the old Heaven and Earth are destroyed. "Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. . . ." (Rev 21:1) This verse means that Hell itself has to pass away. Hell is the means through which Earth will be purified of sin! Sin and sinners will have no place on Earth, in Earth or under the Earth when everything is made new. God's universe will be clean of sin and sinners.
- 6. Reigning with Christ: If there is an eternally burning Hell, what judgment is left for the saints to conduct during the 1,000 years? "Do you not know that the saints will judge the world . . .? Do you not know that we will judge angels . . .?" (1 Cor 6:2,3) Think about this: If all of the wicked receive the same sentence burning in Hell for eternity, then there is nothing left for the saints to judge during the 1,000 years!
- 7. Walking on the Ashes of the Wicked: The Bible declares the wicked will be devoured destroyed annihilated turned into ashes. "Then you will trample down the wicked; they will be ashes under the soles of your feet on the day when I do these things, says the Lord Almighty." (Mal 4:3)
- Christians mess the doctrine of Hell up today largely because people do not understand the
 doctrines of restitution, God's vengeance, soul sleep, the Second Death or the Judgment Bar of
 Christ. I understand how people conclude that the wicked will burn in Hell forever. Language in
 the Bible seems to support the idea of eternal suffering in Hell until you put everything the Bible
 has to say about Hell on the table. Then, and only then, can we understand the truth on this
 topic.

False: Sunday is the Sabbath of the Lord

(1st day of the week)

PART 1

False Doctrine

 \Box It is a false doctrine to claim the 1st day of the week – Sunday, is the sabbath of the Lord.

2190 The sabbath, which represented the completion of the first creation, <u>has been replaced</u> by <u>Sunday</u> which recalls the new creation inaugurated by the Resurrection of Christ.

2191 The Church celebrates the day of Christ's Resurrection on the <u>"eighth day," Sunday,</u> which is rightly called the Lord's Day (cf. SC 106).

2192 "Sunday . . . is to be observed as the foremost holy day of obligation in the universal Church" (CIC, can. 1246 § 1). "On Sundays and other holy days of obligation the faithful are bound to participate in the Mass" (CIC, can. 1247).

2193 "On Sundays and other holy days of obligation the faithful are bound . . . <u>to abstain from those labors</u> and business" (CIC, can. 1247).

2194 The institution of Sunday helps all "to be allowed sufficient rest and leisure to cultivate their familial, cultural, social, and religious lives" (*GS* 67 § 3).

Sunday has no significant whatsoever in the bible. God plainly states that He created the earth and all that is in it in six literal days. And on the Seventh day, He rested. He then blessed and sanctified it, and called it the Sabbath day.

Gen 1:5: And the evening and the morning were the **First** day.

Gen 1:8: And the evening and the morning were the **Second** day.

Gen 1:13: And the evening and the morning were the Third day.

Gen 1:19: And the evening and the morning were the **Fourth** day.

Gen 1:23: And the evening and the morning were the **Fifth** day.

Gen 1:31: And the evening and the morning were the **Sixth** day.

Gen 2:2-3 And on the **Seventh** day God ended his work which he had made; and He rested on the <u>seventh day</u> from all His work which He had made. And <u>God blessed the seventh day</u>, and sanctified it: because that in it He had rested from all His work which God created and made.

⁸ Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. ⁹ <u>Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work:</u> ¹⁰ <u>But the seventh day is the sabbath of the LORD thy God</u>: <u>in it thou shalt not do any work,</u> thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: ¹¹ <u>For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day</u>: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it. Sunday - fulfillment of the sabbath

Jesus did not change the Sabbath. He kept the Sabbath. He did not come to destroy the law.

Jesus kept the Sabbath..."And He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up: And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up for to read." (Luke 4:16)

Jesus said..." Think not that I am come to destroy the law or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil. For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one little shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled." (Matthew 5: 17-19)

"Therefore, the children of Israel shall keep the Sabbath, to observe the Sabbath throughout their generations <u>as a perpetual covenant</u>. It is <u>a sign between Me and the children of Israel forever</u>; for in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, and on the seventh day He rested and was refreshed" (Exodus 31:16-17)

False: Sabbath command was for Jews only

(that only physical Jews are required to keep the Sabbath)

☐ The catholic church refers to the sabbath as the "Jewish sabbath". Meaning that God's fourth commandment of Sabbath was only meant for the Jewish nation.

"There remains, then, a <u>Sabbath-rest</u> for <u>the people of God</u>; (Hebrews 4: 9-11: *NIV, NLT, ASV, RSV*)

"And He said to them, "The <u>Sabbath was made for man</u>, and not man for the Sabbath.." (Mark 2:27)

"...from one Sabbath to another, shall <u>flesh</u> come to worship before Me," says the LORD." (Isaiah 66:22-23).

Sabbath was to be kept even by the Gentiles

"The <u>sons of the foreigner</u> Who join themselves to the Lord, to serve Him, and to love the name of the Lord, to be His servants—<u>Everyone</u> <u>who keeps from defiling the Sabbath</u>, And holds fast My covenant—Even them <u>I will bring to My holy mountain</u>, And make them joyful in My house of prayer....For My House Shall be called a House of Prayer for <u>All Nations</u>" (Isaiah 56:6-8)

False: Person enters sabbath-rest when they die

(that upon death one enters the Sabbath-rest)

False Doctrine

Most Christians in protestant churches have been deceived to believe that one only enter sabbath rest immediately upon death. Others claim there is no command specifically written to the New Testament church mandating the keeping of the Sabbath.

☐ Sabbath rest is the Hebrew word *shabbat*, which means "to rest or stop or cease from work."

The origin of the Sabbath goes back to Creation. After creating the heavens and the earth in six days, God "rested on the seventh day from all His work which He had made" (Genesis 2:2). This doesn't mean that God was tired and needed a rest. We know that God is omnipotent, literally "all-powerful." He has all the power in the universe, He never tires, So, what does it mean that God rested on the seventh day? Simply that He stopped what He was doing. He ceased from His labors. This is important in understanding the establishment of the Sabbath day.

God used the example of His resting on the seventh day of Creation to establish the principle of the Sabbath day rest for His people. In Exodus 20:8-11 and Deuteronomy 5:12-15, God gave the Israelites the fourth of His Ten Commandments. They were to "remember" the Sabbath day and "keep it holy." One day out of every seven, they were to rest from their labors and give the same day of rest to their servants and animals. This was not just a physical rest, but a cessation of laboring. Whatever work they were engaged in was to stop for a full day each week.

■ A sabbath still remains for the Christian church today

[Jesus] "And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up for to read." (Luke 4:16)

[Apostles] "Then Paul, as his custom was, went in to them, and for three Sabbaths reasoned with them from the Scriptures (Acts 17:2).

[Church] The women who followed Jesus body to the tomb.... ⁵⁶ And they returned, and prepared spices and ointments; and rested the sabbath day according to the commandment." (Luke 23:55-56).

[Present Church]"There remains, then, a Sabbath-rest for the people of God; 10 for anyone who enters God's rest also rests from their works, just as God did from his." (Hebrews 4: 4, 9-11)

☐ The dead cannot keep sabbath in the graves

"The dead do not praise the Lord, nor do any who go down into silence" (Psalms 6:5) "all go to one place: all are from dust, and all return to dust." (Eccl 3:20)

False: Ten commandments were abolished

(And that Christians are not required to keep them)

☐ The catholic church abolished the 2nd commandment and changed others. Many protestant churches falsely claim it is Jesus who abolished the commandments.

Truth: The 10 commandments were not abolished

(Jesus did not abolish the commandments)

□ Christ's life and death did not, neither could, abolish anything which in itself was from God; and therefore, was truth. Because Christ, being "the truth" personified, could not thrust aside any truth that God had ever given. Certain things naturally ceased by limitation. Even these He did not abolish. The larger light that was manifested by His life and in His death, swallowed up the lesser light which shadowed His coming. Jesus did not come to change the law; He did not abrogate it. He did not allow even one tittle of it to fail. As long as heaven and earth shall stand, so long will the binding claims of God's law rest upon the human race. Neither a single jot nor tittle of it shall in any wise fail or pass away. It is by the life of Christ we see its exalted character.

False: That the Old Testament was for the Jews and the New Testament for Christians

False Doctrine

Among those who profess to be Christians there are some who in their teachings discard the Old Testament and give their followers to understand that Christians have nothing to do with it in that it was intended to serve the natural Jews alone. For this reason, many people frown upon any reference to texts in the Old Testament. It is generally believed that when Christ died on the cross, He abolished a great many of the truths of the Bible that the Jewish people had believed during their national existence. False claim that Old Testament was God's law to the Jews. False claim that the ten commandments were given to the Jew only - never to the Gentiles and you are not and never were under them. False claim that the Old Testament never contained a plan of salvation, not even for the Jew. False claim you are not under the Old Testament because Jesus took the law of Moses out of the way at his death.

As long as the heavens and the earth shall remain, not a single point of the law shall be annulled. Yea, still more: Heaven and earth could more easily pass away than the smallest tittle of the law could fail. What Christ, however, did abolish, was the tradition and slavishness of men which had bound the people from exercising the freedom of their personal will and choice. He made men free. He destroyed sin. Not that He did away with any truth, or invalidated any of the teachings of the word of God. This the reader should bear in mind.

THE view of some people that the Old Testament of the Bible has been done away with in the Christian Era is, a false hood. Jesus Christ referred to the Old Testament as "the law and the prophets" during his ministry on earth. (Matthew 5: 17; 11: 13; Luke 16: 16). It is both the Old and New that make up "all Scripture" which St. Paul says "is given by inspiration of God and is profitable for doctrine for reproof, for correction in righteousness: that the man of God may be perfect throughly furnished unto all good works." (2 Timothy 3: 16, 17) And remember that Jesus Christ said he came not to destroy the law or the prophets but to fulfill and complete their works. – Matthew 5: 17-19.

Some people quarrel with the Old Testament because of their lack of understanding in regard to the change of the Mosaic Law. In His sacrificial death, Jesus fulfilled the ceremonial laws. Christians are expected to live a holy life; this calls for the practice of righteousness by adhering to the demands of God's word or law of liberty which purifies the worshipper who sincerely acknowledges and puts away his sins. – Acts 10: 34,35; Matthew 5: 20; 6: 33; James. 1:25; 2:12.

The Old Testament is so linked with the New in such a flow of divine thoughts, symbolisms and rules that no true Christian can dispense with a thorough understanding of its significance. Christians are bound to believe the Old Testament but their belief must be backed with a good understanding of the modification of the law through the grace and truth that came by Jesus Christ. – John 1: 17.

False: Christians should not pay tithes

(Giving to God a tenth of all your earnings)

To withhold Tithe is to rob God

Referring to the experience of Abraham and Jacob in paying tithe, was the practice of patriarchs and prophets before the establishment of the Jews as a nation. But when Israel became a distinct people, the Lord gave them definite instruction upon this point: "All the tithe of the land, whether of the seed of the land, or of the fruit of the tree, is the Lord's: it is holy unto the Lord." This law was not to pass away with the ordinances and sacrificial offerings that typified Christ. As long as God has a people upon the earth, His claims upon them will be the same.

A tithe of all our increase is the Lord's. He has reserved it to Himself, to be employed for religious purposes. It is holy. Nothing less than this has He accepted in any dispensation. A neglect or postponement of this duty, will provoke the divine displeasure. If all professed Christians would faithfully bring their tithes to God, His treasury would be full. (SP)

False: Jesus will set his kingdom on earth at His second coming

(that Messiah will rule from Israel for a 1000 years with the saints)

☐ False believe among Jews, and Messianic Jews that Messiah will come to establish a physical kingdom in Israel.

False: Church to be raptured before great tribulation



- 4. That once Christians come back with JESUS, they, together with Jews will start the millennium 1,000 years reign here on this earth.





The adoption of pants as a popular item of dress for women in Western society traces its roots to the <u>mid-19th-century dress-reform movement</u>. In the United States, Elizabeth Smith Miller designed an early version of pants like clothing for women around 1851. God cannot be worshipped like any other gods (<u>Deuteronomy 12:3-4</u>, 30-31). When He instructed His chosen people Israel in the method of His worship, He warned them neither to add to what He had given them, nor take away from it (<u>Deuteronomy 4:2</u>; <u>12:32</u>; see <u>Revelation 22:18-19</u>). For example, notice His terrible wrath when the children of Israel tried to worship Him through the Golden Calf (<u>Exodus 32:1-9</u>). They proclaimed "a feast to the Lord" (verse 5), but He would have none of it! He was so enraged at the people's idolatry that He considered exterminating the whole nation and starting over with Moses' family.

Christianized pagan festivals


Christmas festival: "Birthday of the sun god "Unconquerable Sun,"

On December 25, <u>Dies Natalis of Sol Invictus</u>, or the "<u>Birthday of the Unconquerable Sun</u>," was a popular holiday in the Roman Empire that celebrated the winter solstice as a symbol of the resurgence of the sun, the casting away of winter and the heralding of the rebirth of spring and summer. December 25 therefore became the Christianizing of the dies solis invicti nati ("day of the birth of the unconquered sun").

In addition, members of the Roman upper classes often celebrated the birthday of Mithra, the god of the unconquerable sun, on December 25. It was believed that Mithra, an infant god, was born of a rock. For some Romans, Mithra's birthday was the most sacred day of the year. Saturn, the Roman god of agriculture, and liberation was also celebrated at Saturnalia festivals. It was a time of feasting, role reversals, free speech, gift-giving and revelry. Christian missionaries gave these holidays a makeover and they are now known to us as Christmas.







Easter festival: Mystery Germanic "goddess of Spring and dawn"

The goddess Eostre: - The Mystery Germanic goddess of Spring and dawn who Gave Easter its Name.

Eostre - Anglo-Saxon goddess who was (and remains) tied to the celebration of Spring. On the old

Germanic calendar, the equivalent month to April was called -"Ōstarmānod" – or Easter-month.

The name "Eostre" (Old Germanic "Ostara"), is related to that of _Eos_, the Greek goddess of dawn, and both can be traced back to ancient Proto-Indo-European goddess of dawn. This holiday was called _Pascha_ in Greek and Latin, but somehow acquired the name Easter. How this happened exactly is unknown but is almost certainly related to an Old High German word for dawn — eostarum (the festival was described in Latin as in albis, a plural form of "dawn"). But this points back to the idea of Eostre/Ostara as associated with the dawn, hence the connection of "dawn" to the name. Possibly this would then hint at a connection with life and rebirth (quite a natural fit for a celebration of the Christ Resurrection), and at least infer a possible connection with the Equinox. Christianity was nonetheless not immune to absorbing practices of earlier faiths. Pope Gregory I, in a letter to Abbot Mellitus (a Christian missionary in England at the dawn of the 7th Century) laid out the pragmatism of allowing certain practices be absorbed for the sake of slowwalking populations into Christianity.

Lent fasting

As with many Christian rituals, Lent, a 40-day period of prayer, penance and abstinence, grew out of earlier pagan practices. "Many know of the tradition of abstaining from meat on Fridays and Ash Wednesdays during Lent. The very name, Lent, is an Anglo-Saxon term that refers to the lengthening of the day as spring approaches. For Christians, it has always been viewed as a preparation for Easter. Until the fourth century, however, the fasting that came to characterize the holiday was restricted to a day or two; it never exceeded a week. In some instances, a penance of 40 consecutive hours of abstinence was prescribed. Lent originated as a way for candidates to prepare for baptism, which was to take place at Easter. During the fourth century, this preparatory fasting was justified as a means for cleansing the body of impurities and atoning for sin. Soon, other members of the community began fasting in support of those preparing for baptism and to reaffirm their own faith. Source: "EVOLUTION OF THE LENTEN FAST". "Prosperity gospel, also called prosperity theology, in <u>Protestant Christianity</u>, the teaching that faith—expressed through positive thoughts, positive declarations, and donations to the church—draws health, wealth, and happiness into believers' lives. It is also referred to as the "health and wealth gospel" Central to this teaching are the beliefs that <u>salvation</u> through <u>Jesus Christ</u> includes liberation from not only death and eternal damnation but also poverty, sickness, and other ills. - "Popular revivals are too often carried by appeals to the imagination, by exciting the emotions, by pandering to the love for what is new and startling. Converts thus gained have no more desire to listen to Bible truths, no more interest in the testimony of prophets and apostles, than has the novel-reader. Unless a religious service has something of a sensational character, it has no attractions for them. A message which appeals to unimpassioned reason, awakens no response. The plain warnings of God's word, relating directly to their eternal interests, fall as upon the ears of the dead. The converts are not renewed in heart or changed in character. Did Jesus Cleanse All Foods?

Mark 7: 18-19"Do ye not perceive, that whatsoever thing from without entereth into the man, it cannot defile him; ¹⁹ Because it entereth not into his heart, but into the belly, and goeth out into the draught, <u>purging all meats?"</u>

Some believe Jesus' comments in Mark 7 overturned God's laws about clean and unclean meats. But does this idea stand up under scrutiny of the context?

Mark 7 that some believe shows Jesus abolishing the food laws. They argue that this proves Christians can now freely eat anything they want. some say. Jesus *purified* all foods—so all meats are now lawful to eat. if this were what Jesus was saying, it would mean that swine, shellfish and meat from *all* creatures, including snakes, roaches, dogs and rats are clean to eat. But was Jesus really saying that now a Christian can completely disregard the Old Testament food laws and eat literally *anything*?

A look at the context

The immediate context begins in the early verses of the chapter: "Then the Pharisees and some of the scribes came together to Him, having come from Jerusalem. Now when they saw some of His disciples *eat bread with defiled, that is, with unwashed hands,* they found fault" (verses 1-2, emphasis added). So the issue they were raising was being ceremonially defiled (*koinos* in Greek). An unclean animal was not described as defiled, or common. (In Acts 10:14 Peter distinguishes "common"—*koinos*—from "unclean"—*akathartos*.)

Verse 3 gives a little more detail: "For the Pharisees and all the Jews do not eat unless they wash their hands in a special way, holding the tradition of the elders."

That last phrase—"the tradition of the elders"—is an important key to what is being discussed here. After being taken captive to Babylon for breaking God's laws, the Jews genuinely desired to never allow the same thing to happen again.

Over time, the leaders added a detailed body of oral traditions to the law to make it (in theory) harder to break. The idea was that additional man-made laws built around God's laws would help prevent Jews from getting anywhere near committing sin. These laws were later preserved as the Talmud, which continues to guide the lives of Orthodox Jews today.

The Pharisees and scribes were prominent groups of religious teachers at Jesus' time who heavily emphasized the oral traditions. These traditions included laws on ceremonial hand washing that Jews were supposed to meticulously follow. Since these regulations came not from God, but from men, Jesus didn't strictly mandate them to His disciples.

When the Pharisees and scribes encountered Jesus' disciples, they noticed they weren't washing their hands according to the strict specifications of the traditions—which included pouring water on both hands, lifting them up so water ran down the wrist and forearm, and then rubbing the hands together.

The context makes it clear what He is referring to as *entering* a person. The issue had nothing to do with pork or shellfish. He was talking about what could enter a person's digestive system as a result of eating with ceremonially unwashed hands—perhaps a little dirt. The issue was clean or unclean *hands*—not clean or unclean meats! The main takeaway is that we should be focused on the real teachings of God's Word—not man-made traditions. Using Christ's statements in Mark 7 as justification to eat what God's Word says not to eat is totally missing the point.

False: Church can use carved images, and paintings of dead saints (veneration of images)

False Doctrine

In the catechism of the catholic church, the second commandment is deleted.

Quote: catechism of the catholic church

2132 The Christian veneration of images is not contrary to the first commandment which proscribes idols. Indeed, "the honor rendered to an image passes to its prototype," and "whoever venerates an image venerates the person portrayed in it." The honor paid to sacred images is a "respectful veneration," not the adoration due to God alone:

False: Worshiping of idols

(the sun, moon, stars, creatures, money, people etc.)

No outward shrines may be visible, there may be no image for the eye to rest upon, yet people are practicing idolatry. It is as easy to make an idol of cherished ideas, people or objects as to fashion gods of wood or stone. Thousands have a false conception of God and His attributes. They are as verily serving a false god as were the servants of Baal.

"On Dec. 8, 1854, Pope Pius IX declared the doctrine of the "Immaculate Conception," which proclaimed that the Virgin Mary was "preserved free from all stain of original sin" and throughout her life was "entirely perfect, beautiful, most dear to God and never stained with the least blemish" (Ineffabilis Deus).



It is now a required belief for Roman Catholics. In 1854, Pope Pius IX proclaimed in his Bull Ineffabilis that:

"...We declare, pronounce and define that the doctrine which asserts that the Blessed Virgin Mary, from the first moment of her conception, by a singular grace and privilege of almighty God, and in view of the merits of Jesus Christ, Savior of the human race, was preserved free from every stain of original sin <u>is a doctrine revealed by God</u> and, for this reason, <u>must be firmly and constantly believed by all the faithful</u>."

975 "We believe that the Holy Mother of God, the new Eve, Mother of the Church, continues in heaven to exercise her maternal role on behalf of the members of Christ" (Paul VI, CPG § 15).

966 "Finally the Immaculate Virgin, preserved free from all stain of original sin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory, and exalted by the Lord as Queen over all things, so that she might be the more fully conformed to her Son, the Lord of lords and conqueror of sin and death." ⁵⁰⁸

•On Nov. 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII announced the doctrine of the "Assumption of Mary," declaring that the <u>Virgin Mary's body never died and saw corruption</u>, but was "assumed <u>body and soul into heavenly glory</u>" (*Munificentissimus Deus*).

False: Use of repetitive prayers


(using rosary beads)

False Doctrine

2682 Because of Mary's singular cooperation with the action of the Holy Spirit, the Church loves to pray in communion with the Virgin Mary, to magnify with her the great things the Lord has done for her, and to entrust supplications and praises to her.

"The prayers that comprise the Rosary are arranged in sets of ten Hail Mary's, called <u>decades</u>. Each decade is preceded by one Lord's Prayer and followed by one Glory Be. During recitation of each set, thought is given to one of the Mysteries of the Rosary, which recall events in the lives of Jesus and Mary. Five decades are recited per rosary. Other prayers are sometimes added before or after each decade. Rosary beads are an aid towards saying these prayers in the proper sequence."

False: The 'bread and wine' is the true body of Christ

(true body, and blood of Christ are present in bread and wine in the Lord's supper)

Quote: catechism of the catholic church

1375 It is by the conversion of the bread and wine into Christ's body and blood that Christ becomes present in this sacrament. The Church Fathers strongly affirmed the faith of the Church in the efficacy of the Word of Christ and of the action of the Holy Spirit to bring about this conversion

1410 It is Christ himself, the eternal high priest of the New Covenant who, acting through the ministry of the priests, offers the Eucharistic sacrifice. And it is the same Christ, really present under the species of bread and wine, who is the offering of the Eucharistic sacrifice.



1418 Because Christ himself is present in the sacrament of the altar, he is to be honored with the worship of adoration. "To visit the Blessed Sacrament is . . . a proof of gratitude, an expression of love, and a duty of adoration toward Christ our Lord" (Paul VI, *MF* 66).

1413 By the consecration the <u>transubstantiation of the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ is brought about</u>. Under the consecrated species of bread and wine <u>Christ himself, living and glorious, is present in a true, real, and substantial manner</u>: his Body and his Blood, with his soul and his divinity (cf. Council of Trent: DS 1640; 1651).

Jesus did not give his own literal body and blood to the Apostles, but the bread and wine **that represented (symbolized)** his own body and blood.

²³ For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, that the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed <u>took bread</u>: And when he had given thanks, he <u>brake it</u>, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: <u>this do in remembrance of me</u>.

²⁵ After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, this cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as often as ye drink it, in remembrance of me.

²⁶ For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord's death till he come. (1 Corinthians 11:23-27)



False: Jesus made Peter the rock

(that Peter is the rock upon which the church was established)

False Doctrine

☐ Catholic church claims its authority on the premise that Jesus founded His Church on Peter. But did "on this rock I will build My church" refer to Peter?

936 The Lord made St. Peter the visible foundation of his Church. He entrusted the keys of the Church to him. The bishop of the Church of Rome, successor to St. Peter, is "head of the college of bishops, the Vicar of Christ and Pastor of the universal Church on earth" (CIC, can. 331).

869 The Church is apostolic. She is built on a lasting foundation: "the twelve apostles of the Lamb" (*Rev* 21:14). She is indestructible (cf. *Mt* 16:18). She is upheld infallibly in the truth: Christ governs her through Peter and the other apostles, who are present in their successors, the Pope and the college of bishops.

870 "The sole Church of Christ which in the Creed we profess to be one, holy, catholic, and apostolic, . . . subsists in the Catholic Church, which is governed by the successor of Peter and by the bishops in communion with him. Nevertheless, many elements of sanctification and of truth are found outside its visible confines"(*LG* 8).

Jesus Christ built His true Church on Himself. Jesus Christ is the Rock and chief cornerstone on which His Church is built—not a man. The Bible clearly identifies Jesus as this rock. Jesus is called "the chief cornerstone" seven times in the New Testament (Matthew 21:42; Mark 12:10; Luke 20:17; Acts 4:11; Ephesians 2:20; 1 Peter 2:6-7). In 1 Corinthians 10:4 the apostle Paul refers to Christ as "that spiritual Rock that followed them, and that Rock was Christ."

¹⁰ And have ye not read this scripture; <u>The stone which the builders rejected is become</u> the head of the corner: (Mark 12:10), (Psalms 118:22)

⁷ Unto you therefore which believe he is precious: but unto them which be disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner, And a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offence, even to them which stumble at the word, being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed. Truth: Jesus Christ did not build His Church on Peter

- Matthew 16:18 has been used to claim Peter and those considered his successors were given nearly
 unlimited spiritual authority. Is this what Jesus said? Jesus had posed a question to His disciples: "Who do
 men say that I, the Son of Man, am?" Peter spoke up first—eventually giving the *right* answer (verse 16).
 Instead of just complimenting Peter for speaking correctly, Jesus Christ made a statement about rocks.
- "And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it" (verse 18). Peter, Christ, rocks, church, gates of Hades. Christ packed a lot into this short statement! So what exactly was He talking about?

One interpretation of "on this rock I will build My church"

- The Roman Catholic Church essentially believes that Christ was saying this: "And I also say to you that you are Peter (the rock), and on you, Peter, I will build My one Holy Catholic Church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it." This interpretation forms the basis of the doctrine of the primacy of Peter, the idea that Christ founded the church on Peter. He was the foundation and was given the "keys of the kingdom of heaven" (verse 19)—supreme authority to establish doctrine and govern the church.
- This theology leads to the connected doctrine of papal succession. The Roman Catholic Church believes Peter moved to Rome and led the church from Rome for about 25 years until his martyrdom in A.D. 67. They believe Peter started a succession of popes that continues unbroken to this day (from Pope Linus to Pope Francis), and that each of these succeeding popes carries the same authority that Christ supposedly gave Peter in Matthew 16:18-19.

The consequences of this belief: popes who changed biblical doctrine

- Believing that Peter and those they claim are his successors are truly "the rock" on which Christ built His Church and are the possessors of the "keys," the Roman Catholic Church has therefore claimed the authority to declare doctrine—even changing or adding to biblical doctrines. Catholics maintain that when a pope speaks ex cathedra (Latin for "from the chair" of St. Peter), he is exercising this power in its fullness. Ex cathedra asserts that "when the pope in his official capacity, with the fullness of his authority, as successor of St. Peter and head of the Church on earth, proclaims a doctrine of faith or morals binding on the whole Church, he is preserved from error" (John A. O'Brien, The Faith of Millions, 1963, pp. 110-111).
- In fact, one of the pope's primary titles is *vicar of Christ*, which implies "his supreme and universal primacy, both of honour and of jurisdiction, over the Church of Christ" (*Catholic Encyclopedia*). The idea is that the pope stands in place of Christ as His representative on earth—endowed with Christ's own authority—which was originally given to Peter. The Roman Catholic Church has used this authority to change or proclaim many doctrines that are not taught in the Bible.


What Jesus really meant by "on this rock I will build My church"

- So, was Jesus really building the Church on Peter (and his successors) in Matthew 16:18? Let's look more closely at the verse. Understanding this passage in its original language, Greek, provides the key to understanding what Christ meant. Jesus used a wordplay that isn't clear when read in English. First, Jesus used the word *Petros* when referring to Peter: "I also say to you that you are Peter [*Petros*]." He then used a similar-sounding word to describe what He was building His Church on: *Petra*. "And on this rock [*petra*] I will build My church."
- So, Christ's statement actually reads like this: "I also say to you that you are *Petros*, and on this *petra* I will build My Church." He distinguished the rock (*petra*) He was building the Church on from Peter (*petros*). The rock He was building His Church on was a rock big enough to serve as the chief cornerstone in the foundation; it was large, strong and immovable. This describes none other than Jesus Christ Himself!

False: Partaking of the body of Christ with non believers



"Scientists have calculated that Earth is **4.54 billion years old**, with an error range of 50 million years. Many scientists arrive at the age of 4.54 billion years by relying on radiometric dating,. They say some rocks contain trace amounts of radioactive atoms. Those radioactive atoms decay into stable atoms over time. By knowing the decay rate and measuring the amount of both kinds of atoms in a rock, scientists can compute the amount of time it took to produce the stable atoms. The examination and analysis of rocks on Earth's surface, and of extraterrestrial rocks, have enabled scientists to determine the approximate age of the planet". **(Source: National geographic and space.com)**

The falsehoods of Modern Science

Learning from brightest minds on earth - the scientists, professors and geniuses in explaining critical questions of beginning of things.

1. How old is the universe? How old is Earth?

Using data from the Planck space observatory, scientists have found the universe to be approximately 13.8 billion years old. Just how old is Earth? By dating the rocks in Earth's ever-changing crust, as well as the rocks in Earth's neighbors, such as the moon and visiting meteorites, scientists have calculated that Earth is 4.54 billion years old, with an error range of 50 million years. Scientists have scoured the Earth searching for the oldest rocks to radiometrically date. In northwestern Canada, they discovered rocks about 4.03 billion years old. Then, in Australia, they discovered minerals about 4.3 billion years old.

2. How Long Have Humans Been On Earth?

While our ancestors have been around for about six million years, the modern form of humans only evolved about 200,000 years ago. The Homo group — including our own species, Homo sapiens — began arising more than two million years ago.

3. Where did humans originate?

.....

Humans are apes (superfamily Hominoidea). The gibbons (family Hylobatidae) and orangutans (genus Pongo) were the first living groups to split from this lineage, then gorillas, and finally, chimpanzees (genus Pan). The splitting date between human and chimpanzee lineages is placed 8–4 million years ago, during the late Miocene epoch, with a more constrained interval 8–7 million proposed by some geneticists. The earliest record of Homo is the 2.8 million-year-old specimen LD 350-1 from Ethiopia, and the earliest named species are Homo habilis and Homo rudolfensis which evolved by 2.3 million years ago.

4.Did humans evolve? Where did humans come from in the beginning?

According to evolution theory developed by Charles Darwin, evolution is the change in the characteristics of a species over several generations and relies on the process of natural selection. The theory of evolution is based on the idea that all species are related and gradually change over time. Humans first evolved in Africa, and much of human evolution occurred on that continent. The fossils of early humans who lived between 6 and 2 million years ago come entirely from Africa. Most scientists currently recognize some 15 to 20 different species of early humans.

6. How old is our sun?

The sun was born about 4.6 billion years ago. Many scientists think the sun and the rest of the solar system formed from a giant, rotating cloud of gas and dust known as the solar nebula.

7. How was the universe formed? Where did our universe came from?

Our universe began with an explosion of space itself - the Big Bang. Starting from extremely high density and temperature, space expanded, the universe cooled, and the simplest elements formed. The Big Bang theory says that the universe came into being from a single, unimaginably hot and dense point (aka, a singularity) more than 13 billion years ago.

8. How was the earth formed?

.....

When the solar system settled into its current layout about 4.5 billion years ago, Earth formed when gravity pulled swirling gas and dust in to become the third planet from the Sun.

9. When was the first living thing on Earth?

Some scientists estimate that 'life' began on our planet as early as four billion years ago. And the first living things were simple, single-celled, micro-organisms called prokaryotes (they lacked a cell membrane and a cell nucleus). Others think life began in ponds on land, perhaps geothermal pools like those in Yellowstone.

"Evolution over billions of years denies God's Word, undermines the Gospel. The key point about the evolutionary story is that these events were *not observed*. No one saw any of these things happen. Every part of this story involves huge swathes of guesswork, and was constructed *by people* who were not there. 
The numerical value of the Latin words 'Vicarius Filii Dei' is 666.

False: Christians believers and Jews await the coming of two different Messiahs

False Doctrine

The belief that Christians and Jews await the return two different Messiahs at the end of the age: the Christians await (The Messiah who died and rose from the dead-Jesus Christ) while the Jews and Messianic Jews await the coming of a physical Messiah 'whose features remain hidden till the end of time.'

Quote: catechism of the catholic church

840 And when one considers the future, <u>God's People of the Old Covenant</u> and the <u>new People of God</u> tend towards similar goals: expectation of the coming (or the return) of the Messiah. <u>But one awaits the return of the Messiah</u> who died and rose from the dead and is recognized as Lord and Son of God; <u>the other awaits the coming of a Messiah</u>, <u>whose features remain hidden till the end of time</u>; and the latter waiting is accompanied by the drama of not knowing or of misunderstanding Christ Jesus.





- 2. Divided Rome: The dragon has seven heads and ten horns and seven crowns upon his head (Rev 12:3).
- **3. Papal Rome**: The beast received its power, throne and great authority from the dragon and ruled for **42 months** (1260 years (Rev 13:5 and 11:2).
- **4.** Roman Papacy: The beast will rule the world once again after the deadly wound is healed (Rev 13:3, 12).
- 1. Pagan Rome: The fourth beast alone: (Daniel 7:7).
- 2. Divided Rome: The fourth beast with ten horns: (Daniel 7:24).
- **3.** Papal Rome's first stage: The fourth beast with the <u>little horn</u> ruling for three and one half prophetic years (1260 years)- (Daniel 7:9).
- **4.** Roman Papacy second stage: Fourth beast when the <u>little horn is restored to</u> power: (*Revelation 13: 12*)

Many early protestant reformers identified Roman Catholic Papacy to be the antichrist

Apostle Paul warned the church that it was not to look for the coming of Christ in his day. "That day shall not come," he says, "except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed." Not till after the great apostasy, and the long period of the reign of the "man of sin," can we look for the advent of our Lord. The "man of sin," which is also styled the "mystery of iniquity," the" son of perdition," and "that wicked," represents the papacy, which, as foretold in prophecy, was to maintain its supremacy for 1260 years. This period ended in 1798. The coming of Christ could not take place before that time. Paul covers with his caution the whole of the Christian dispensation down to the year 1798.

John Calvin (1509-1564) (Presbyterian): "Some persons think us too severe and censorious when we call the Roman pontiff Antichrist. But those who are of this opinion do not consider that they bring the same charge of presumption against Paul himself, after whom we speak and whose language we adopt... I shall briefly show that (Paul's words in II Thess. 2) are not capable of any other interpretation than that which applies them to the Papacy." (Taken from Institutes of the Christian Religion, by John Calvin.)

John Wesley (1703-1791) (Methodist), Speaking of the Papacy, John Wesley wrote: "He is in an emphatical sense, the Man of Sin, as he increases all manner of sin above measure. And he is, too, properly styled the Son of Perdition, as he has caused the death of numberless multitudes, both of his opposers and followers... He it is...that exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped...claiming the highest power, and highest honour...claiming the prerogatives which belong to God alone." Antichrist and His Ten Kingdoms, by John Wesley, pg. 110.

Thomas Cranmer (1489-1556) (Anglican): "Whereof it followeth Rome to be the seat of antichrist, and the pope to be very antichrist himself. I could prove the same by many other scriptures, old writers, and strong reasons." (Referring to prophecies in Revelation and Daniel.) Works by Cranmer, Vol. 1, pp. 6-7.

Roger Williams (1603-1683) (First Baptist Pastor in America): Pastor Williams spoke of the Pope as "the pretended Vicar of Christ on earth, who sits as God over the Temple of God, exalting himself not only above all that is called God, but over the souls and consciences of all his vassals, yea over the Spirit of Christ, over the Holy Spirit, yea, and God himself...speaking against the God of heaven, thinking to change times and laws; but he is the son of perdition (II Thess. 2)." In: The Prophetic Faith of Our Fathers, by Froom, Vol. 3, pg. 52.

The Westminster Confession of Faith (1647):

"There is no other head of the church but the Lord Jesus Christ. Nor can the pope of Rome in any sense be head thereof; but is that Antichrist, that man of sin and son of perdition that exalteth himself in the church against Christ and all that is called God."

And all the people did say, Amen! A holy terror siezed their souls. It was Antichrist whom they beheld seated on the pontifical throne. This new idea, which derived greater strength from the prophetic descriptions launched forth by Luther into the midst of his contemporaries, inflicted the most terrible blow on Rome."


