SEVEN STEPS

TO RECEIVING THE CORRECT BAPTISM

A biblical account of receiving the correct baptism and of entering the kingdom of God and His Son.

- 1. Hear the good news.
- 2. Know.
- 3. Believe.
- 4. Repent.
- 5. Receive 1st baptism (of water).
- 6. Receive 2nd baptism (of the holy Spirit).
- 7. Become an adopted child (into the kingdom of God).

Each step is a must condition that has to be fulfilled before anyone is allowed to enter into the kingdom of God. The steps are sequential (although steps 5 and 6 can be interchanged at God's discretion). An unbelief in any step leads to the automatic disqualification from entering the kingdom of God. As you will see, each of the above steps reveal Jesus Christ to us.

Step 1 to baptism

HEAR THE GOOD NEWS

What is the good news?

Acts 5:42 "They did not cease teaching and preaching JESUS AS THE CHRIST".

Acts 11:20: "Preaching THE LORD JESUS."

Rom 16:25: "Preaching of JESUS CHRIST."

2Co 10:14: "Preaching THE GOSPEL OF CHRIST."

Acts 8:35: "Preached JESUS to him".

Acts 17:18: "Preached TO THEM JESUS and the resurrection".

Acts 10:36: "Preaching peace by JESUS CHRIST: (He is Lord of all)"

The good news is the Lord Jesus Christ. He was Anointed and sent by his Father to earth to reveal his Father's love for us so that by believing in him, we might have eternal life.

Jesus Christ is the good news of the kingdom of God revealed.

- a. "...Preaching and bringing the GLAD TIDINGS OF THE KINGDOM OF GOD." Luke 8:1:
- b. "... Preached the THINGS CONCERNING THE KINGDOM OF GOD and THE NAME OF JESUS CHRIST". Acts 8:12:
- c. "...Jesus came into Galilee, <u>preaching</u> THE GOSPEL OF THE KINGDOM OF GOD, And saying, The time is fulfilled, and THE KINGDOM OF GOD IS AT HAND: repent ye, and believe the gospel." Mark 1:15
- d. "Jesus began to <u>preach</u> and to say, "Repent, **FOR THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN IS AT HAND.**" Matthew 4:17
- e. "...Since that time **THE KINGDOM OF GOD** has been <u>preached</u>." Luke 16:16:

JESUS Christ brought to us the good news of the kingdom of GOD. John Baptist was the first prophet to preach Jesus as the Christ and to prepare the way for the earthly visitation of a Son of a heavenly King. The Apostles, the firsthand witness of the son of God, afterwards preached JESUS was the CHRIST, the Son of God.

Step 2 to baptism **KNOW**

Know what?

- a. "And this is life eternal, that they might KNOW thee THE ONLY TRUE GOD, and JESUS CHRIST, whom thou hast sent". (John 17:3)
- b. "...And that the world may KNOW that YOU (GOD) HAVE SENT ME (JESUS), and have loved them as You have loved Me. (John 17:23)
- c. "...that you may KNOW and believe that THE FATHER (GOD) IS IN ME (JESUS), AND I (JESUS) IN HIM (GOD)." (John 10:38) brackets mine.
- d. "Therefore let all the house of Israel KNOW assuredly, that GOD HATH MADE THE SAME JESUS, whom ye have crucified, BOTH LORD AND CHRIST." (Acts 2:36)
- e. "And we KNOW that the SON OF GOD IS COME, and hath given us an understanding, THAT WE MAY KNOW HIM (GOD) THAT IS TRUE, and we are in him (GOD) that is true, even IN HIS SON JESUS CHRIST". (1 John 5:20) brackets mine.
- f. "These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; THAT you may KNOW that you have eternal life, and that you may BELIEVE ON THE NAME OF THE SON OF GOD". (1 John 5:13)
- g. "And you KNOW that he (JESUS CHRIST) was manifested to take away our sins; and in him (JESUS) is no sin". (1 John 3:5) brackets mine
- h. "...That you may KNOW that THE SON OF MAN (JESUS CHRIST) has power on earth to forgive sins" (Matthew 9:6) Brackets mine
- i. "He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" Simon Peter answered and said, "YOU ARE THE CHRIST, THE SON OF THE LIVING GOD." (Matthew 16:15-16)

Have a correct and accurate knowledge of who the only true living God is and Jesus Christ. Know that the living God, made his Son Jesus both Lord and Christ, and sent him to take away our sins, that whoever believes in his name may have eternal life.

Step 3 to baptism

BELIEVE

Believe on what?

- a. "That we should **BELIEVE ON THE NAME OF HIS SON JESUS CHRIST".** (1 John 3:23)
- b. "And they said, <u>BELIEVE ON</u> THE LORD JESUS CHRIST, and thou shalt be saved". (Acts 16:31)
- c. "Whosoever **BELIEVETH THAT JESUS IS THE CHRIST** is born of God (1 John 5:1)
- d. "These things have I written unto you that <u>BELIEVE ON</u> THE NAME OF THE SON OF GOD; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may <u>BELIEVE ON</u> THE NAME OF THE SON OF GOD". (1 John 3:23)
- e. "And <u>WE BELIEVE</u> AND ARE SURE THAT THOU ART THAT CHRIST, THE SON OF THE LIVING GOD. (John 6:67-69)
- f. "I BELIEVE THAT JESUS CHRIST IS THE SON OF GOD. (Acts 8:37-38)
- g. "But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that **BELIEVE ON HIS (JESUS) NAME:**" (John 1:12) Brackets mine
- h. "...Whosoever <u>BELIEVES IN</u> **HIM (JESUS)** should not perish, but have everlasting life". (John 3:16) brackets mine.
- i. "...Whoever <u>BELIEVES IN</u> THE SON (JESUS) has eternal life". (John 3:36)
- j. "Even so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that WHOEVER <u>BELIEVES IN</u> HIM (JESUS) should not perish but have eternal life. (John 3:15) Bracket mine
- k. "...Everyone who SEES THE SON AND <u>BELIEVES IN</u> HIM (JESUS) may have everlasting life." (John 6:39) brackets mine
- I. "Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should <u>BELIEVE ON</u> HIM which should come after him, THAT IS, ON CHRIST JESUS.
- m. "But these are written, that ye might <u>BELIEVE THAT</u> JESUS IS THE CHRIST, THE SON OF GOD; and that believing ye might have <u>life through his name</u>. (John 20:31)

Believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God, and by believing this we may have eternal life

REPENT

Step 4 to baptism

PART 1

Repent what?

- a. 'Thus says the Lord GOD: "REPENT, TURN AWAY FROM YOUR IDOLS, and turn your faces away from all your abominations. (Ezekiel 14:6)
- b. "REPENT now everyone of his EVIL WAY and his EVIL DOINGS", (Jeremiah 25:5)
- c. "REPENT, and TURN FROM ALL YOUR TRANSGRESSIONS, so that iniquity will not be your ruin. Cast away from you all the transgressions which you have committed, and get yourselves a new heart and a new spirit. For why should you die, O house of Israel? (Ezekiel 18:30)
- d. "REPENT therefore and be converted, THAT YOUR SINS MAY BE BLOTTED OUT, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord. (Acts 3:19)
- e. "If we <u>CONFESS</u> OUR SINS, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9)
- f. "Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but <u>NOW COMMANDS ALL MEN</u> <u>EVERYWHERE TO **REPENT**</u>, because He has appointed a day on which He will judge the world in righteousness by the Man whom He has ordained. (Acts 17:30).
- g. "<u>REPENT</u>, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. (Acts 2:38).

Philosophical, mystic and spiritualistic conception of God and his Son is sin that leads to idol worship. God is not a mystery. His Son Jesus Christ is not a mystery. We must not only repent our many transgression and evil ways, but also confess our sins of false conception of God and Jesus Christ that destroys their personality through trinity mystery

Who forgives? Because JESUS CHRIST continues forever, he has an unchangeable priesthood, "He is able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them." (Hebrews 7:25)

"For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.) – Roman 5:17

What is sin?


- a. "Sin is the transgression of the law". (1 John 3:4)
- **b.** "All unrighteousness is sin" (1 John 5:17)
- c. "Whoever commit sin transgresses the law" (1 John 3:4)
- **d. "For by the law is the knowledge of sin".** (Romans 3:20)

He that commit sin is of the devil (1 John 3:8)

Which law?

²⁹ Jesus answered him, "The first of all the commandments is: 'Hear, O Israel, the LORD our God, the LORD is one. ³⁰ And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' This is the first commandment. Mark 12:29-31

³¹ And the second, like *it*, *is* this: <u>'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'</u> There is no other commandment greater than these." Mark 12:29-31 ⁹ For the commandments, "You shall not commit adultery," "You shall not murder," "You shall not steal," "You shall not bear false witness," "You shall not covet," and <u>if there is any other commandment</u>, are *all* summed up in this saying, namely, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." Romans 13:8-10



Step 5 to baptism

RECEIVE 1ST Baptism

Born of water

The first baptism is the baptism of water (by full emersion). This is performed by a believer with the same faith as yours (see qualifications in Ephesians 4:4-6)

- a. "Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto you, <u>EXCEPT A MAN BE BORN OF WATER</u> AND OF THE SPIRIT, HE CANNOT ENTER into the kingdom of God." (John 3:5)
- b. "I indeed BAPTIZE YOU WITH WATER unto repentance. (Matt 3:11).
- c. "I indeed BAPTIZED YOU WITH WATER." (Mark 1:8)
- d. "There is also <u>an antitype which now saves us</u>—<u>baptism</u> (...), through the resurrection of Jesus Christ" (1 Peter 3:21).
- e. "BAPTIZED INTO JESUS CHRIST were baptized into his death? Therefore we are BURIED WITH HIM BY BAPTISM INTO DEATH: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection: (Romans 6:4)
- f. "BURIED WITH HIM (JESUS) IN BAPTISM, wherein also YOU ARE RISEN WITH HIM (JESUS) through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead. (Colossians 2:12) brackets mine

One must receive two baptisms, without which one cannot enter the kingdom of God.

Step 6 to baptism

Receive 2nd Baptism

Born of the holy Spirit

The second baptism is being given the holy Spirit. It is performed by Jesus Christ only. He is the one who baptizes the believers by pouring his Spirit to those that believe on his name. (He breathed on his disciples his Holy spirit).

- a. "HE WILL <u>BAPTIZE</u> YOU WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT." (Mark 1:8).
- b. "Upon whom you see the Spirit descending, and remaining on Him, THIS IS HE WHO BAPTIZES WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT." (John 1:33).
- c. "He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. HE WILL <u>BAPTIZE</u> YOU WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT AND FIRE". (Matt 3:11)

The two baptisms do not follow chronologically, either can precede the other. For example, some were given the holy Spirit before being baptized with water. Others were baptized with water then given the holy spirit.

When Jesus gives us his Spirit, he gives himself to us (Spirit of prophecy explains).

- a. "Christ gives the (believers) the **BREATH OF HIS OWN SPIRIT, the LIFE OF HIS**OWN LIFE" (DA 827.3)
- b. "In GIVING US HIS SPIRIT, GOD GIVES US HIMSELF..." (Testimonies Vol 7, p. 273, 1902).
- c. "The <u>comforter is the holy spirit</u>, **THE SOUL OF HIS LIFE**" (Review and Herald, May 19, 1904 par 1)

Step 7 to baptism

ADOPTED AS CHILDREN OF GOD

Given right to enter in the kingdom of God

- a. "As MANY AS RECEIVED HIM (JESUS), to them HE GAVE THE RIGHT TO BECOME CHILDREN OF GOD, to those who believe in his name:" (John 1: 12) brackets mine.
- b. And **THIS IS LIFE ETERNAL**, that <u>they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ</u>, whom thou hast sent. (John 17:3)
- c. "If anyone loves Me (JESUS), he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and **WE (FATHER AND SON) WILL COME TO HIM AND MAKE OUR HOME WITH HIM**. (John 14:23-24) brackets mine.
- d. "And this is testimony: that **GOD HAS GIVEN US ETERNAL LIFE, AND THIS LIFE IS IN HIS SON.** (1 John 5:11).
- e. "Do you not know that **YOU ARE THE TEMPLE OF GOD** and that **the spirit of God dwells in you**? (1 Cor. 3:16–17).
- f. "There is now **NO CONDEMNATION FOR THOSE IN CHRIST JESUS**, because the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and death (Romans 8:1)

After believing and being baptized with water and the holy spirit, you become an adopted child of God. The Father and Son comes and dwells in you through their one shared Spirit. You are accepted as part of God's heavenly family and made a partaker of God's heavenly gift of eternal life. The spirit of Jesus that indwells in you henceforth puts a conditional immortality in your life. It seals You for resurrection in the last day.

A strict condition to enter the kingdom has to be met by anyone who enters.

"Assuredly, I say to you, <u>WHOEVER DOES NOT RECEIVE THE KINGDOM OF</u>
 <u>GOD AS A LITTLE CHILD</u> will <u>BY NO MEANS ENTER IT</u>." (Mark 10:15 Luke
 18:17)

IN THIS ENTIRE PROCESS, WHO SAVES?

Who has eternal life of the believers?

- "Therefore HE (JESUS) IS ALSO ABLE TO SAVE TO THE UTTERMOST those who
 come to God (Father) through him (Jesus), since He always lives to make
 intercession for them. (Hebrews 7:25) brackets mine.
- "Nor is there salvation in any other, for THERE IS NO OTHER NAME UNDER HEAVEN given among men BY WHICH WE MUST BE SAVED." (Act 4:12)
- God has given to us eternal life, and <u>THIS LIFE IS IN HIS SON</u>. <u>He that has the</u> <u>Son has life;</u> and he that has not the Son of God has not life." (1 John 5:10-12)
- "Even when we were dead in sins, HATH QUICKENED US TOGETHER WITH CHRIST, (by grace ye are saved;)... And hath raised us up together, and MADE US SIT TOGETHER IN HEAVENLY PLACES IN CHRIST JESUS: (Ephesians 2:1,5,6)

Thus, eternal LIFE IS ONLY FOUND IN JESUS CHRIST, NO ONE ELSE. And one must have the correct knowledge of GOD and his Son JESUS, in order to believe them. Jesus was given eternal life to give those who believe in him as the literal Son of God.

THE BIBLE TELLS US

THERE IS 'ONLY ONE TRUE LIVING GOD'

- a. Have we no all one father? Hath not one God created us? (Malachi 2:10)
- b. "I am the Lord, and there is none else, <u>there is no God beside me</u>." (Isa. 45:5). "I am God, and <u>there is none else</u>." (Verse 22).
- c. "I am the first, and I am the last; and <u>beside me there is no God</u>. Is there a God beside me? yea, <u>there is no God; I know not any</u>." (Isa. 44: 6, 8).
- d. "For thou art great, and doest wondrous things; thou art God alone." (Ps. 86:10).
- e. "Before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me." (Isa. 43:10).
- f. "Thou, even thou, art Lord alone; thou bast made heaven, the heaven of heavens, with all their host, the earth, and all things that are therein, the seas, and all that is therein, and thou preservest them all." (Neh. 9:6).
- g. "See now that I, even I, am he, and there is no god with me." (Deut. 32:39).
- h. "Thou art great, 0 Lord God: for there is none like thee, <u>neither is there any God beside</u> <u>thee.</u>" (2 Sam. 7: 22).
- i. "Thou art the <u>God, even thou alone</u>, of all the kingdoms of the earth; thou bast made heaven and earth." (2 Kings 19:15).
- j. "Hear, 0 Israel: **The Lord our God is one Lord**." (Deut. 6:4).
- k. "Thou shalt have **no other gods before me**." (Ex. 20:3). *All others were false.*
- I. "Unto thee it was showed, that thou mightest know that the Lord he is God; there is none else beside him." (Deut. 4:35).

And this One God has an only begotten Son

"<u>For God</u> so loved the world that <u>He gave His only begotten Son</u>, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life". (John 3:16-17).

God and his Son share one mindset, one glory, one power; that is, one Spirit (Ep 2:18, Eph 4:4, 1Co 12:13,8)

THE FALSE TRINITY DOCTRINE TELLS US


THERE ARE '3-IN-ONE' GOD

The false trinity doctrine explains and misrepresent the true God and his Son as "Three Gods existing in one, and one God existing in three.

Now here is the deception: these 3-in-1 God (or 1-in-3) are said to be coequal, coeternal and self-existent. Meaning each one is equal to the to other, existed from the eternity past alongside the other and self-existent meaning none came from inside the other. They parallel coexisted from eternity and are all self-independent of each other. Wait a minute! doesn't the name son denote a male born of a father? Doesn't Jesus call himself a Son?

For the trinity doctrine to hold, the truth that Jesus is a Son born of a Father and God is a father of a literal son has to be deceptively twisted. Therefore, the name Father and Son are made symbolic names, (that is, a representation, a metaphorical or a philosophical). So Jesus is not a true born son and the father is not a true father, in the sense that he did not literally bore a son. They assume that in the drama of salvation, this one God played the role of a Father, (called himself God the Father), played the role of a son (called himself God the Son), and played the role of the holy spirit (called himself God the holy spirit). In the 3-in-1 concept, each is fully God, thus having 3 separate individual Gods (Father, Son and holy Spirit). This effectively destroys the true biblical meaning while in disguise retaining these names. Think of how little innocent children plays a game of parents; one playing the symbolic role of a father (calls himself father) and the other mother. The trinity doctrine does exactly the same, it destroys the true personality of God the Father and his begotten Son Jesus.

Thus, the trinity doctrine creates a third fictitious personal God unknown in heaven called "God the holy spirit". This third God is satan himself in disguise, wanting to receive worship just like the Father and the Son. This is the cleverest deception of satan; a strong, almost overmastering delusion. Many have been ensnared in this falsehood.



IN TRINITY BAPTISM, ONE CANNOT BE GIVEN THE SPIRIT OF CHRIST

Why?

The trinity baptism completely destroys the true baptism by creating a third God in the salvation of mankind. Yet the bible says God alone sent his Son. So in trinity baptism, instead of those baptized receiving the spirit belonging to Christ, they receive this third god — a fully fledged, coequal, coeternal and self existent god called "God the holy spirit", unknown in heaven. What a masterly deception! What a lie!

So instead of a believer being "led by the spirit of God", thus becoming "sons of God" (Roman 8:14), they are led by the evil spirit of satan, while being deceived it is the holy spirit. Satan wearing a clothing of righteousness. Thus the words are fulfilled that says "And no marvel; for satan himself is transformed into and angel of light" (2Co 11:14). In all this, satan has taken advantage of us, because we have become ignorant of his devices (2Co 2:11).

"You are of your father the devil...he was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it" (John 8:44).

Those who allow themselves to be deceived get the devil as their father, and receives the evil spirits of demons.

The kingdom of God has got only one true God (the Father) and one true Son of the Father(Jesus the Christ). And it is the Son's spirit we are given to indwell in our hearts, and not another separate God when we are baptized.

A BELIEVER OF TRINITY DOCTRINE DOES NOT BELONG TO JESUS CHRIST

It is the spirit of Jesus Christ that gives life, and not "god the holy spirit" as those who believe in the false trinity doctrine claims.

- a. "You, however, are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if indeed <u>THE SPIRIT OF GOD LIVES</u>
 <u>IN YOU</u>. IF ANYONE DOES NOT HAVE THE SPIRIT OF CHRIST, HE DOES NOT BELONG TO
 HIM". (Rom 8:9)
- b. "Now **IF CHRIST IS IN YOU,** the body is dead because of sin, but **THE SPIRIT GIVES LIFE** because of righteousness". (Rom 8:10)
- c. "And IF THE SPIRIT OF HIM WHO RAISED JESUS from the dead LIVES IN YOU, then he who raised Christ from the dead will also bring your mortal bodies to life THROUGH HIS SPIRIT WHO LIVES IN YOU". (Rom 8:11)
- d. 'Now **THOSE WHO BELONG TO CHRIST JESUS** have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires'. Gal 5:18 'But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law'. Gal 5:16 I say, then, walk by the Spirit and you will certainly not carry out the desire of the flesh.
- e. Rom 8:13: "if you live according to the flesh, you are going to die. But **IF BY THE SPIRIT** you put to death the deeds of the body, **you will live**." (Gal 5:24)
- f. "Now the mindset of the flesh is death, but **THE MINDSET OF THE SPIRIT** is life and peace". (Rom 8:6-8)

NOTICE the interchangeably use of the words; "if Christ is in you" and "his Spirit who lives in you" "the spirit gives life", "mindset of the spirit" and "if anyone does not have the spirit of Christ", all indicating one and the same person [JESUS CHRIST].

If anyone does not have the spirit of Christ (that is, Christ in you), he does not belong to him. He belongs to another father - the devil.

You are a thief and a robber if...

You climb in any other way, apart from Jesus, you become a thief.

- 1. "Verily, verily, I say unto you, **HE THAT ENTERETH NOT BY THE DOOR** into the sheepfold, but climbeth up some other way, the same **IS A THIEF AND A ROBBER**." (John 10:1)
- 2. "All that came ever came before me **are thieves and robbers**, <u>but the sheep did not hear them</u>". (John 10:8)

A thief and a robber will not inherit the kingdom of God.

Those who enter through the door of false baptism of trinity enter not into the correct way. They also receive not the spirit of Jesus but "god the holy spirit" that is unknown in heaven. They thus qualify to become thieves and robbers. They receive the spirit of the devil.

Conclusion

The bible tells us there are only 2 Divine Beings;

ONE GOD

"Before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me."

(Isa. 43:10).

"I am the Lord, and there is none else, there is no God beside me."

(Isaiah 45:5-6, Isaiah 45:8, Joel 2:27)

Jesus answered, "The most important is Listen, Israel! **The Lord our God, The Lord is one.** The scribe said to him, "You are right teacher. You have correctly said that he is one, and there is no one else except him.

(Mark 12: 29,32)

ONE SON OF GOD

"These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.

(1 John 3:23)

"These are written, that <u>you may believe</u> that **JESUS IS THE CHRIST, the Son of God**; and that believing ye **might have life through his name**".

(John 20:31)
