SUMMARY OF THE BOOK

What is the Spirit of prophecy?

“...the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.” (Revelation 19:10)

Jesus is the Word, and no prophecy comes to us except through Him, ultimately pointing to God as the source of all true prophecy. In Revelation 1:1, 2, the phrase “testimony of Jesus” describes a revelation that Jesus gave to the apostle John who bore witness to the seven churches concerning things “which must shortly take place” (Rev. 1:1). The book of Revelation reveals Christ’s mind regarding future events. Revelation 19:10 says, “the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.” The people who receive this spirit of prophecy in this verse are “the brethren,” which is a term Revelation later uses for prophets (Rev. 22:9). In other words, the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy given to the prophets. The prophetic message gives the church a clearer picture of Jesus’ mind, heart, and plans for the future.

What is prophecy, then? Prophecy is communication from God the Father to mankind, through Jesus, through his angels, through his prophets. Prophets were utilized as a mouthpiece for God to convey God’s message to the masses.

1. Jesus is the substance of all prophecy, or, put another way, Jesus is the common theme among all prophecy.
2. All true prophecy and prophets bears witness about Jesus. Therefore, all prophecy should cause us to worship God the Father through his Son Jesus. (cf. John 17:3; 1 Timothy 1:17; 6:15; 1 Samuel 7:4)

Who created the earth?

The bible vs the lies of modern science

The Big bang theory

Our modern education, through scientific disciplines like geology, geoscience, geophysics, archaeology, earth science, and astronomy, explains the creation of Earth and the universe, with the Big Bang theory. This is falsehood that is contrary to the Word of GOD.

The most widely accepted scientific theory explaining the origin of the universe is the "Big Bang Theory," which proposes that the universe began as an incredibly dense and hot point that rapidly expanded outwards, creating all matter and space. The Big Bang theory says that the universe came into being from a single, unimaginably hot and dense point (aka, a singularity) more than 13 billion years ago. The Earth formed from a giant cloud of gas and dust surrounding the young sun. Gravity pulled the material together, and it eventually coalesced into the planet we know today. *(The University of Chicago)*

The Evolution Theory

From the lies of modern science

The brightest minds on earth - the scientists, professors and geniuses use the evolution theory developed by Charles Darwin in 1844 to explain critical questions of beginning of things.

1. Just how old is Earth?

“Scientists have calculated that Earth is **4.54 billion years old**, with an error range of 50 million years. Many scientists arrive at the age of 4.54 billion years by relying on radiometric dating. They say some rocks contain trace amounts of radioactive atoms. Those radioactive atoms decay into stable atoms over time. By knowing the decay rate and measuring the amount of both kinds of atoms in a rock, scientists can compute the amount of time it took to produce the stable atoms. (Source: National geographic and space.com)

2. How Long Have Humans Been On Earth?

Some scientists estimate that 'life' began on our planet as early as four billion years ago. And the first living things were simple, single-celled, micro-organisms called prokaryotes (they lacked a cell membrane and a cell nucleus). While our ancestors have been around for about six million years, the modern form of humans only evolved about 200,000 years ago. The Homo group — including our own species, Homo sapiens — began arising more than two million years ago.

3. Where did humans originate?

Humans are apes (superfamily Hominoidea). The gibbons (family Hylobatidae) and orangutans (genus Pongo) were the first living groups to split from this lineage, then gorillas, and finally, chimpanzees (genus Pan). The splitting date between human and chimpanzee lineages is placed 8–4 million years ago, during the late Miocene epoch, with a more constrained interval 8–7 million proposed by some geneticists. The earliest record of Homo is the 2.8-million-year-old specimen LD 350-1 from Ethiopia, and the earliest named species are Homo habilis and Homo rudolfensis which evolved by 2.3 million years ago.

God testifies in the spirit of prophecy the above are lies

“How often the supposed deductions of science are revised or cast aside; with what readiness the assumed period of the earth’s development is from time to time increased or diminished by millions of years; and how the theories advanced by different scientists conflict with one another—considering all this, shall we, for the privilege of tracing our descent from germs and mollusks and apes, consent to cast away that statement of Holy Writ, **so grand in its simplicity, ‘God created man in His own image, in the image of God created He him’** (Genesis 1:27)? **Shall we reject that genealogical record**,—prouder than any treasured in the court of kings,—‘which was the son of Adam, which was the son of God’ (Luke 3:38) (Education, 130)?

From the Creator of the earth

Just 42 generation from Abraham to Christ.

“So all the generations from Abraham to David are **14 generations**; and from David until the carrying away into Babylon are **14 generations**; and from the carrying away into Babylon unto Christ are **14 generations**” (Matthew 1:17)

The genealogies of man from Abraham to the birth of Christ, are explained in the books of Gen 5:1-32, Matt 1:1-17, and Luke 3:1-38. If you add up the years of these genealogies up to Christ, they give an accurate total of 4000 years. From Christ crucifixion (31 A.D) to present is almost 2000 years. Thus, our earth is just about 6,000 years old.

“The lives recorded in the Bible are authentic histories of actual individuals. From Adam down through successive generations to the times of the apostles we have a plain, unvarnished account of what actually occurred and the genuine experience of real characters” (Testimonies for the Church 4:9)

Earth is nearly 6,000 years old

What exactly did God create in the beginning?

did God also create the universe when the earth was created?

If you read **Genesis chapter 1** meticulously, the creation story is a detailed account of the creation of this earth we call home (and things inside it), and an expanse above the earth (called heaven) where the sun and moon were positioned to serve specific functions for the Earth. The first sentence, Genesis 1:1, is ideally a concise summary of the rest of the chapter.

- ❖ ¹ In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.
- ❖ ² The earth was without form, and void;
- ❖ ⁶ Then God said, “Let there be a firmament [expanse] in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters.” ⁷ Thus God made the firmament,...⁸ And God called the firmament Heaven.
- ❖ ¹⁴ Then God said, “Let there be lights in the firmament of the heavens to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs and seasons, and for days and years; ¹⁵ and let them be for lights in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth”; and it was so.
- ❖ ¹⁶ Then God made two great lights: the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night. the stars also.
- ❖ ¹⁷ God set them in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth, ¹⁸ and to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the light from the darkness.

NB: The ‘stars’ question

The mention of ‘*stars also*’ in Genesis 1:16 seems out of place in the context, as it disrupts the flow of the narrative. The verses before (Verse 14) discusses the creation of lights in the heavens to separate day and night. Verse 15 give their purpose as to illuminate the Earth. Jump to verse 17, it continues the very narrative by detailing the placement of these two great lights (sun and moon) in the firmament to provide light to the Earth. Thus, the inclusion of stars in verse 16 seem disconnected from this explanation. Again, stars neither separate day and night nor give light to the earth. Unless, the ‘stars’ has another meaning from what we generally think it to mean.

The answer

What God created in the beginning we behold it with our own eyes. So, what constitute the earth, with the sun at its center that give light during the day, and the moon at night? **Its our SOLAR SYSTEM.** Indeed, our solar system consists of the Sun and everything gravitationally bound to it. **Does our solar system have stars? No.** Then, from the observable things in our solar system, what else do we see at night? **Other planets** like Mercury, Venus, Mars, etc. These are the stars in Gen 1:16.

How long did it take to create the earth?

Science

Over billion of years

Scientists teach the Earth was formed through natural processes over billions of years. The standard model for the formation of the Solar System (including the Earth) is the solar nebula hypothesis. In this model, the Solar System formed from a large, rotating cloud of interstellar dust and gas called the solar nebula. Earth formed in this manner about 4.54 billion years ago (with an uncertainty of 1%) and was largely completed within 10–20 million years. In June 2023, scientists reported evidence that the planet Earth may have formed in just three million years, much faster than the 10–100 million years thought earlier. https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/History_of_Earth#:

The first six days of each week are given to man in which to labor, because God employed the same period of the first week in the work of creation. The seventh day God has reserved as a day of rest, in commemoration of his rest during the same period of time after he had performed the work of creation in six days. But the infidel supposition that the events of the first week required seven vast, indefinite periods for their accomplishment, strikes directly at the foundation of the Sabbath of the fourth commandment. Where is our tiny earth located in the great cosmos teeming with billion of galaxies?

Have you ever wondered what galaxy is the Earth in? it's in the Milky Way Galaxy. The Earth is located in the Solar System, and the Solar System is located about 25,000 light-years away from the core of the galaxy. This also means that the earth is about 25,000 light-years away from the outer edge of the Milky Way. The Earth is located in one of the spiral arms of the Milky Way called the Orion Arm, which lies about two-thirds of the way out from the center of the Galaxy. The Orion arm is a minor arm located in between the two major galactic arms.

If you go to a dark spot, away from the bright city lights, and look up, you should be able to see the Milky Way as a cloudy band stretching across the sky (see image on the right). It really does look like spilt milk spread across the sky. But if you take a telescope and examine it more closely, you'll see that the clouds are actually the collective light from thousands of stars.


Since we're embedded inside the Milky Way, we're seeing our home galaxy edge-on, from the inside. To get a better idea, grab a dinner plate and take a look at it edge on, so you can't see the circular shape of the galaxy. You can only see the edge of the plate.

The Milky Way is an example of a barred spiral galaxy. It measures approximately 100,000 light years across and it's 1,000 light years thick; although, it's more thick at the core where the galaxy bulges out. If you could fly out of the Milky Way in a rocket and then look back, you'd see a huge spiral shaped galaxy with a bar at the center(see diagram below). At the ends of this bar, there are two spiral arms which twist out forming the structure of the Milky Way.







In comparison to other created worlds, our earth is like a Jot, a speck or a little atom





"This world is but a little atom in the vast domain over which God presides, and yet this little fallen world is more precious in His sight than the ninety and nine which went not astray from the fold." TTM 324.2

The Answer

The "morning stars", and "all the sons of God" shouted for joy in celebration as they saw God creating the earth (not the universe).

- Notice the use of conjunction "And" denoting there are two groups of beings who witnessed in verse 7.
- Most importantly, notice "ALL" the sons. This include each and every created being in the entire universe as a witness of earth creation.
- Since we know the angelic beings (morning stars) reside in the heavenly Jerusalem, where did the other sons of God reside if at all there were not other inhabited worlds?

"In the work of creation, when the dawn of the first day broke, and the heavens and the earth, by the call of infinite power, came out of darkness; responsive to the rising light, the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy."—The Signs of the Times, January 1, 1880.

Are there other inhabited worlds out there in the universe?

Ellen G. White testifies what she was shown of the Other Worlds

“The Lord has given me a view of other worlds. Wings were given me, and an angel attended me from the city to a place that was bright and glorious. The grass of the place was living green, and the birds there warbled a sweet song. The inhabitants of the place were of all sizes; they were noble, majestic, and lovely. They bore the express image of Jesus, and their countenances beamed with holy joy, expressive of the freedom and happiness of the place. I asked one of them why they were so much more lovely than those on the earth. The reply was, “We have lived in strict obedience to the commandments of God, and have not fallen by disobedience, like those on the earth.” Then I saw two trees, one looked much like the tree of life in the city. The fruit of both looked beautiful, but of one they could not eat. They had power to eat of both, but were forbidden to eat of one. Then my attending angel said to me, “None in this place have tasted of the forbidden tree; but if they should eat, they would fall.” Then I was taken to a world which had seven moons. There I saw good old Enoch, who had been translated. On his right arm he bore a glorious palm, and on each leaf was written “Victory.” Around his head was a dazzling white wreath, and leaves on the wreath, and in the middle of each leaf was written “Purity,” and around the wreath were stones of various colors, that shone brighter than the stars, and cast a reflection upon the letters and magnified them. On the back part of his head was a bow that confined the wreath, and upon the bow was written “Holiness.” Above the wreath was a lovely crown that shone brighter than the sun. I asked him if this was the place he was taken to from the earth. He said, “It is not; the city is my home, and I have come to visit this place.” He moved about the place as if perfectly at home. I begged of my attending angel to let me remain in that place. I could not bear the thought of coming back to this dark world again. Then the angel said, “You must go back, and if you are faithful, you, with the 144,000, shall have the privilege of visiting all the worlds and viewing the handiwork of God.” Early Writings, 39, 40. (Published in 1882.)

“Man was created a free moral agent. Like the inhabitants of all other worlds, he must be subjected to the test of obedience.—Patriarchs and Prophets, 331, 332.

“Should all the inhabitants of this little world refuse obedience to God, He would not be left without glory. He could sweep every mortal from the face of the earth in a moment, and create a new race to people it and glorify His name. God is not dependent on man for honor. He could marshal the starry host of heaven, the millions of worlds above, to raise a song of honor and praise and glory to his name.—The Review and Herald, March 1, 1881, par17.

Did other worlds already existed when Satan rebelled?

Yes, at the time of Satan rebellion, other worlds, and their inhabitants were already created.

“When you look at the cross of Calvary, you cannot doubt God's love or His willingness to save. He has worlds upon worlds that give Him divine honor, and heaven and all the universe would have been just as happy if He had left this world to perish; but so great was His love for the fallen race that He gave His own dear Son to die that they might be redeemed from eternal death.” RH March 9, 1886, par. 26

“Would it not have cast a reflection upon God if He had destroyed him [Satan], he who had taken hold of the very heart of the universe, and the world that was created?” Ms. 8, 1888.

“Satan was greatly loved by the heavenly beings, and his influence over them was strong. Some course must be pursued to uproot him from their affections. God's government included not only the inhabitants of heaven, but of all the created worlds; and Satan thought that if he could carry the intelligences of heaven with him in rebellion, he could also carry with him the other worlds.—The Review and Herald, March 9, 1886, par 4.

“But Christ declared that not one jot or tittle of the law should fail until heaven and earth should pass away. The very work that he came to do was to exalt the law, and show to the created worlds and to heaven that God is just, and that his law need not be changed.” RH March 9, 1886, par. 22

“As the ministry of Christ commences, the battle between light and darkness waxes stronger. And as he cries out upon the cross in his expiring agony, “It is finished,” a shout of triumph rings through every world and through heaven itself. The great contest that has been going on in this world for so long is ended, and Christ is conqueror. His death has now answered the question whether there was self-denial with the Father and the Son”. RH March 9, 1886, par. 16

The penalty of the transgression of God's law is death. Christ suffered death for man, and brought life and immortality to light by coming from the dead. When he died, the death knell of Satan was sounded. The work of Christ was to destroy him who had the power of death; therefore we are today prisoners of hope. How grateful we should be that, notwithstanding this earth is so small amid the created worlds, God notices even us. The nations are before him as the drop in the bucket, and as the small dust in the balance; and yet the great, the stupendous work that has been done for us shows how much he loves us. RH March 9, 1886, par. 19

Was the great controversy to be taken to unfallen worlds?

Satan controversy started when God consulted his Son on creation of man, and Satan felt he should have been included in that consultation. He claimed the world to be created for man as his. God limited his influence to this world, and not others.

Spirit of prophecy testimony

If God were like us, we would expect to hear him say, "Let the world go; let Satan have it for his own." But I am so thankful that God is not like man. He so loved the creatures of his care that he provided a way by which they might be brought back to their Eden home. But at what an immense cost was this provision made! It was no less than by giving up his own dear Son, who was equal to himself, to bear the penalty of the transgressor. The controversy was not to be taken into the other worlds of the universe; but it was to be carried on in the very world, on the very same field, that Satan claimed as his. —The Review and Herald, March 9, 1886, par. 9.

"God's government included not only the inhabitants of heaven, but of all the worlds that He had created; and Lucifer had concluded that if he could carry the angels of heaven with him in rebellion, he could carry also all the worlds."—Patriarchs and Prophets, 41

"When you look at the cross of Calvary, you cannot doubt God's love or His willingness to save. He has worlds upon worlds that give Him divine honor, and heaven and all the universe would have been just as happy if He had left this world to perish; but so great was His love for the fallen race that He gave His own dear Son to die that they might be redeemed from eternal death. As we see the care, the love, that God has for us, let us respond to it; let us give to Jesus all the powers of our being, fighting manfully the battles of the Lord. We cannot afford to lose our souls; we cannot afford to sin against God. Life, eternal life in the kingdom of glory, is worth everything. But if we would obtain this precious boon, we must live a life of obedience to all of God's requirements; we must carry out the principles of the Christian religion in our daily life". Do inhabitants of unfallen worlds see what happens in this world?

Yes, they do. Unfallen beings in other worlds see what happens in this world.

Shall we visit other unfallen worlds?

“And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. ³And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God.” (Revelation 21:1-3)

Ellen G. White was shown the following in vision:

“December 16, 1848, the Lord gave me a view of the shaking of the powers of the heavens. I saw that when the Lord said "heaven," in giving the signs recorded by Matthew, Mark, and Luke, He meant heaven, and when He said "earth" He meant earth. The powers of heaven are the sun, moon, and stars. They rule in the heavens. The powers of earth are those that rule on the earth. The powers of heaven will be shaken at the voice of God. Then the sun, moon, and stars will be moved out of their places. They will not pass away, but be shaken by the voice of God. Dark, heavy clouds came up and clashed against each other. The atmosphere parted and rolled back; then we could look up through the open space in Orion, whence came the voice of God. The Holy City will come down through that open space. I saw that the powers of earth are now being shaken and that events come in order. War, and rumors of war, sword, famine, and pestilence are first to shake the powers of earth, then the voice of God will shake the sun, moon, and stars, and this earth also. I saw that the shaking of the powers in Europe is not, as some teach, the shaking of the powers of heaven, but it is the shaking of the angry nations.”


High resolution image of the great Orion nebula



The Orion Nebula

A high-resolution image taken by Hubble Space Telescope

The Orion Nebula is about 1,500 light-years away from Earth. The Orion Nebula is visible with the naked eye even from areas affected by light pollution. It is seen as the middle "star" in the "sword" of Orion, which are the three stars located south of Orion's Belt. It has a mass of about 2,000 times that of the Sun. A light-year is the distance that light travels in one year. The mouth of a cavern, a deep opening receding into the mighty distance beyond. "The opening in Orion ... stretches many trillions of kilometers. And this is the enormous width of the colossal opening which leads into the cavern."



Shown here is a very deep image (more than 15 hours of total exposure time) of the **Great Nebula** region in the **Sword of Orion** taken from the **New Forest Observatory** in Brockenhurst, England. The Great Nebula (M42), though approximately 1,350 light years away, can be observed with the naked eye even from many urban locations.

Are the 10 commandments kept in other Inhabited Worlds?

Many seem to have the idea that this world and the heavenly mansions constitute the universe of God. **Not so.** SDA Bible Commentary 7:990.

The God who created the earth

- ☐ “In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.” And God made two great lights; the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: he made the stars also. (Genesis 1:1)

Has a Son

- ☐ Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all the ends of the earth? what is his name, and what is his son's name, if thou canst tell? Every word of God is pure: Proverbs 30:4-5

His name is

- ☐ I am the Lord: that is my name: (Isaiah 42:8)
- ☐ I will cause them to know mine hand and my might; and they shall know that my name is The Lord. (Jeremiah 16:21)

And His Son's name is

- ☐ And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name Jesus: for he shall save his people from their sins. (Matthew 1:21)
- ☐ But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; (John 20:31)

That GOD is just one, not a trinity.

“For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour; Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; (1 Timothy 2:5)

How many God(s) participated in the creation?

- ❑ “And God said, let US make man in our image, after our likeness: So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.” (Gen 1:26-27).

Many say that the world God in Gen 1:1 is in the plural form (i.e. Elohim). They thus claim there must have been more than one God who participated in the creation. The mention of the spirit in verse 2 “*And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.*” makes them to conclude that three divine personal beings, composing Elohim created the world. Is this biblical truth?

Who is He that told the other let us create man?

- ❑ “Giving thanks unto the **Father**, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom **of his dear Son**: Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature: **FOR BY HIM WERE ALL THINGS CREATED, that are in heaven, and that are in earth**, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: **ALL THINGS WERE CREATED BY HIM, AND FOR HIM**”. (Colossians 1:12-16).
- ❑ “He was in the world, and **THE WORLD WAS MADE BY HIM**, and the world knew him not. And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. (John 1:10).
- ❑ “And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in **‘GOD [Father], who [Father] created all things by Jesus Christ:’**” (Ephesian 3:9) (brackets supplied by me).
- ❑ “God [Father], who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, Hath in these last days spoken unto us **BY HIS SON**, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, **BY WHOM [Christ] ALSO HE [Father] MADE THE WORLDS;** Who [Christ] being the brightness of his glory, and the EXPRESS IMAGE of his person...” (Hebrews 1:1-3) (brackets supplied by me).

It is crystal clear that the FATHER was telling His Son, let us create man. And so, Jesus executed his Father’s will.

The spirit of prophecy testifies also

“After the earth was created, and the beasts upon it, the FATHER AND SON CARRIED OUT THEIR PURPOSES, . . . And now GOD SAID TO HIS SON, ‘LET US MAKE MAN IN OUR IMAGE.’”
(The Spirit of Prophecy, vol. 1, pp. 24, 25)

How did Jesus create the world?

The process of creating

(The **'How'** will inform us the process, and the method Jesus used to create). We have learned it's Jesus who created everything. So, which method did He use? First, we already know he used his bare hands to form ADAM and EVE. But what did he used to create the heaven, the earth, plants, cows and goats, and all other things?.

"In the beginning **God created** the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form and void, and darkness was upon the face of the deep. **And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.** And GOD SAID, Let there be light: and there was light." (Genesis 1:1-2).

Please note key words and their order: God (through Jesus) created" >> the spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters >> God SAID".

THE ACTUAL PROCESS OF CREATING: HE SPAKE AND HIS WORD WOULD CREATE

Verse 3	"And God SAID, Let there be light: and there was light."
Verse 6	"And God SAID, Let there be a firmament...and God made the firmament,"
Verse 9	"And God SAID, Let the waters be gathered".
Verse 11	"And God SAID, Let the earth bring..."
Verse 14	"And God SAID, Let there be lights ...and God made two great lights;"
Verse 20	"And God SAID, Let the waters bring..."
Verse 24	"And God SAID, Let the earth bring forth the living creature".

Meaning of the word **"SAID"** (H559) = (to say, **spake**, utter, **command**, tell"). Therefore, Jesus was speaking, and his words/utterances "let there be", would create what he said.

Question 1: What was Jesus speaking to or directing his words/commands to?

- Answer: He was speaking to the very first thing he created in verse 1: "the heaven and earth."

Question 2: What was the state/condition of this heaven and the earth he was speaking to?

- Answer: The earth was formless (shapeless), it was void (empty), and the heavens were dark (without light). In the entire physical surface of the earth, there was nothing in it. Parallel verse for Gen 1:2 is Jeremiah 4:23: "I beheld the earth, and, lo, it was **without form**, and **void**; and the heavens, and they had **no light**." (Jeremiah 4:23)

Who/What is that Spirit of God that moved upon the face of the waters?

. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters." (Genesis 1:1-2)

1. The breath of His nostrils/mouth

"THE LORD THUNDERED FROM HEAVEN, and THE MOST HIGH UTTERED HIS VOICE.....And the channels of the sea appeared, the foundations of the world were discovered, at the rebuking of the LORD, AT THE BLAST OF THE BREATH OF HIS NOSTRILS." (2Sa 22:14) see also (Psa 18:13 and 1 SA 7:10)

"By THE WORD of the LORD were the heavens made; and all the host of them BY THE BREATH OF HIS MOUTH. He gathereth the waters of the sea together as a heap: he layeth up the depth in storehouses. (Psalms 33:6-9)

Lesson learned: The Lord thundering, that is, the utterances of His voice>>which in other words is the blast of the breath/air of His nostrils moved upon the surface of the earth forming things.

2. His spoken words

Let all the earth fear the LORD: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him. FOR HE SPAKE, and IT WAS DONE; HE COMMANDED, and IT STOOD FAST." (Psalms 33:6-9)

"The WORLDS WERE FRAMED BY THE WORD of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear. (Hebrews 11:3).

Lesson learned: He Spoke the Word > by the BREATH of his mouth" > and it was created. Meaning, that the breath of the Lord's mouth as he spoke the words, those words went across the face of the earth creating the things out of nothing. So, in Jesus's words carried his creating mighty power.

3. His spirit/Command

"Thou SEND FORTH THY SPIRIT, THEY ARE CREATED: and thou renewest the face of the earth." (Psalms 104:30)

"Praise him, ye heavens of heavens, and ye waters that be above the heavens. Let them praise the name of the LORD: FOR HE COMMANDED, AND THEY WERE CREATED. (Psalms 148:4-6)

Lesson learned: the Lord sent forth his Spirit/command >> and they were created. The spirit (command) of Jesus spread across the empty universe, as they did so, it was creating.

The Spirit of God *'that moved upon the face'* of the waters.

The mighty blasts of waves in Jesus' words that moved upon the face of the waters

The Spirit of God *'moved upon the face'* of the waters. The Spirit "breath" that Jesus' words formed blasted and roared across the face of the earth as they formed what Jesus intended. How loud and powerful would Jesus's voice have been to transcend across the entire earth's surface and the entire universe?

"Listen carefully to **the thunder of God's voice as it rolls from his mouth**. It **rolls across the heavens**, and his lightning flashes in every direction. Then comes the roaring of the thunder— **the tremendous voice of his majesty**. He does not restrain it when he speaks. God's voice is glorious in the thunder. We can't even imagine the greatness of his power." (Job 37:2-4 NLT)

"Hear attentively **THE THUNDER OF HIS VOICE**, And **THE RUMBLING THAT COMES FROM HIS MOUTH**. He sends it forth under the whole heaven, His lightning to the ends of the earth. After it a voice roars; **HE THUNDERS WITH HIS MAJESTIC VOICE**, And He does not restrain them when His voice is heard. **GOD THUNDERS MARVELOUSLY WITH HIS VOICE**; He does great things which we cannot comprehend. (Job 37:2-4 NKJV)

"The voice of the LORD is upon the waters: **the God of glory thundereth**: the LORD is upon many waters. The voice of the LORD is powerful; the voice of the LORD is full of majesty." (Psalm 29:3)

"And, behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the east: and **HIS VOICE WAS LIKE A NOISE OF MANY WATERS**: and the earth shined with his glory." (Ezekiel 43:2)

THE SPIRIT: "THE WORDS" FORMED BY THE BREATH OF YOUR MOUTH AND THEIR POWER

Words are formed by the breath and movements of the mouth, tongue, and vocal cords. When we speak, air from our lungs passes through the vocal cords, causing them to vibrate and produce sound. This sound is then modified by the movements of the tongue, lips, and other parts of the mouth to create different sounds, which are combined to form words. So, in essence, words are indeed formed by the breath and the physical actions of the mouth.

Day one of creation

GENESIS 1:1-2: The translated English words and their original Hebrew meaning;

1. In the beginning GOD: (Elohim).
2. Created: (to create, shape, form).
3. Heaven: (sky, visible heavens).
4. Earth formless and void: (land empty, nothing, wilderness).
5. Darkness: (darkness, obscurity).
6. Upon the face of the deep: (abyss, deep places).
7. The Spirit: ('ruah': wind, breath, exhalation, mind, blast).
8. Of GOD: (of Elohim).
9. Moved upon the face of: (blast, movement of the breath/wind across the surface of).
10. The waters. (water e.g., of seas)
11. God said: (speak, to utter).
12. Let there be: (to come about, come to pass, exist, happen).
13. God saw the light: (to see).
14. It was good: (pleasant, agreeable).
15. God divided: (separate).

Notice all these events happened within the first day, and not ages as many falsely claim. And it was Jesus who was executing these commands through the words of his mouth.

Verse interpretation:

Firstly, Jesus spoke and his words formed/shaped the sky and the land mass from nothingness. Once these formed, the newly formed earth's surface was utterly empty and dark, and its deep places were covered with water. Jesus again spoke and his words moved across the surface of the dark earth to create light. Then Jesus spoke yet again and his words went across the surface of the earth separating light from darkness. After that, he spoke for the last time to name the light Day and darkness Night. Day 4 of creation

“And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years: And let them be for lights in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth: and it was so. And God made two great lights; the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: he made the stars also. And God set them in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth, And to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the light from the darkness: and God saw that it was good.” (Genesis 1:16-17)

Verse Interpretation:

4. The distance from Earth to Jupiter is approx. 778 million kilometers
5. The distance from Earth to Pluto is approx. 5.9 billion kilometers.


“He does great things which we cannot comprehend.” (Job 37:5)
